January training, convoy and hunting for Pōhakuloa Training Area (PTA)

PŌHAKULOA TRAINING AREA, HILO, HAWAII (December 19, 2022) —

TRAINING: For the community's awareness, there is minimal training at Pōhakuloa Training Area and minimal convoys in January from Kawaihae Harbor to PTA. Convoys may occur during the day and night times, and schedules are fluid. There will be weapons qualification, aerial operations and other individual and collective training. On-going military training may be heard by surrounding communities, and subject to change based on safety, weather and other environmental factors. Weather, such as overcast conditions can increase noise and vibrations. Should individuals hear noise, there is no immediate danger.

The military appreciates the understanding and continued support of the community. While sometimes loud, this training is critical to ensure military units and service members are ready to accomplish their mission and return home safely. **More details to come next month.**
