Pōhakuloa Training Area Hunting, Convoy Movements

PŌHAKULOA TRAINING AREA, HILO, HAWAII (March 7, 2023) —

TRAINING:

For the community's awareness, there will be mortar, small arms and aircraft gunnery training throughout this month. These are routine unit training and not large-scale exercises. Convoys are expected to travel from/to Kawaihae Dock March 14, 16, 17, and 22. Convoys with more than five vehicles will not move during peak traffic times. We ask you to use caution and not weave in-out of convoys for your safety, as well as the troops.

The military appreciates the understanding and continued support of the community. While sometimes loud, this training is critical to ensure military units and service members are ready to accomplish their mission and return home safely.
