Key Themes: Increase Variety, Hours, and Availability (MWR and AAFES); Living Conditions; Pricing

MWR EVENTS / AAFES

- ✓ Leisure Needs Survey: Survey installation to see what the population wants
- ✓ Decrease recreational equipment pricing during off season (ie boats)
- ✓ High OPTEMPO forced to choose between MWR events and home time
- ✓ Enhance advertisement
- ✓ Don't make MWR events feel like they are mandatory for SMs to attend
- ✓ More variety: Karaoke, indoor range, eateries, VR room, Woodshop, "Top Golf", roller/ ice skating rink, etc.

Special Accomplishments:

Mr. Quick served as the DPTMS Chief of Plans & Operations and Chief of Operations for the month of September, working two pay grades above his own. During this time, Mr. Quick chaired two Installation Working Groups to determine potential Garrison rotational support gaps, prepared the Installation Severe Weather IPR, prepared and facilitated the Garrison Commander's Update Brief (CUB), served as the Operations Branch Chief and covered duties as the Senior Operations Person for P&O Division all within that month.

Recommendation:
