WHAT: Halloween 2022

WHO: Fort Polk DES

WHEN: 31 October 2022

<u>WHERE:</u> Fort Polk Housing Areas that include Maple, Dogwood, and Palmetto Terraces

<u>WHY:</u> To ensure safety for all Trick or Treaters in the housing areas during the times of 1800-2100.

MAJOR OBJECTIVES:

- Coordinate with each community center for command post for each housing area
- Transport of equipment to/from community centers
 Check of Radios
- Placement plan of Carts and UTV's
- Provide safety for the community that will be participating in Halloween
- Checking the walking paths that run through the housing areas

<u>Summary</u>: DES Will conduct additional foot, golf cart, and Utility Terrain Vehicle patrols in the housing areas during the time of trick or treating. Each community center in the housing areas will be used as a command post for that area of housing. Two additional patrols for each housing area will provide security and presence patrol. Register weapons (5 business days)	Conceal carry/Open carry
Keep ammo and weapons separate in vehicles	Carry/Travel with loaded weapons
Store weapons in YOUR housing residence	Store Weapons in barracks/vehicles/office

- Registration form is located at the Visitor Control Center (ACP 1)
 - ✓ (337) 531-0380
- Must register if living on-post **or** you intend to bring weapon(s) on installation **or** to Toledo Bend
- May transfer registration from previous installation

LOUISIANA CONCEAL CARRY

What: Allows conceal carry of a handgun without a permit or training

Who: Louisiana *resident veterans* (active duty, retired, honorably/generally discharged)

When: 1 August 2022

Where: State of Louisiana (does not apply on Fort Polk, LA or on Federal property)

How: Must have a valid **LA** I.D./**LA** issued license displaying "veteran", and/or a DD 214/military I.D., (must tell law enforcement that you are carrying concealed)
