DPTMS- Make Preparedness a Plan

Complete a Written Plan

Complete a plan today. Your family may not be together if a disaster strikes, so it is important to know which types of disasters could affect your area. Know how you'll contact one another and reconnect if separated. Establish a family meeting place that's familiar and easy to find.

Step 1: Put a plan together by discussing the questions below with your family, friends or household to start your emergency plan.

- How will I receive emergency alerts and warnings?
- What is my shelter plan?
- What is my evacuation route??
- What is my family/household communication plan?
- Do I need to update my emergency preparedness kit?



Step 2: Consider specific needs in your household.

As you prepare, tailor your plan and supplies to your specific daily living needs and responsibilities. Discuss the responsibilities, and how people in the network can assist each other with communication, care of children, business, pets or specific needs like operating medical equipment. Create your own personal network for specific areas where you need assistance.

Keep in mind some these factors when developing your plan:

- Different ages of members within your household
- Responsibilities for assisting others
- Medical and Dietary needs including prescriptions and equipment
- Disabilities or access and functional needs including devices and equipment
- Pets or service animals
- Households with school-aged children



If a disaster strikes, what will happen to your pets?





Basic Disaster Supplies

The following are recommendations for your emergency kit. Assemble items for your kit and store in an airtight plastic bags, plastic bins or a duffel bag. Once you look at the basic items, consider what unique needs your family might have, such as supplies for pets or seniors.

- Water (one gallon per person per day for at least three days, for drinking and sanitation)
- Food (at least a three-day supply of non-perishable food)
- Battery-powered or hand crank radio and a NOAA Weather Radio with tone alert
- Flashlight
- First aid kit
- Extra batteries
- Whistle (to signal for help)
- Dust mask (to help filter contaminated air)
- Plastic sheeting and duct tape (to shelter in place)
- Moist towelettes, garbage bags and plastic ties (for personal sanitation)
- Wrench or pliers (to turn off utilities)
- Manual can opener (for food)
- Local maps
- Cell phone with chargers and a backup battery



Additional Emergency Supplies

CDC recommends including additional items in disaster kits to help prevent the spread of coronavirus or other viruses and the flu.

- Cloth face coverings (for everyone ages 2 and above), soap, hand sanitizer, disinfecting wipes to disinfect surfaces
- Prescription medications
- Non-prescription medications such as pain relievers, anti-diarrhea medication, antacids or laxatives
- Prescription eyeglasses and contact lens solution
- Infant formula, bottles, diapers, wipes and diaper rash cream
- Pet food and extra water for your pet
- Cash or traveler's checks
- Important family documents
- Sleeping bag or warm blanket for each person
- Complete change of clothing appropriate for your climate and sturdy shoes
- Fire extinguisher
- Matches in a waterproof container
- Feminine supplies and personal hygiene items
- Mess kits, paper cups, plates, paper towels and plastic utensils
- Paper and pencil, books, games, puzzles or other activities for children



Maintaining Your Kit

After assembling your kit remember to maintain it so it's ready when needed:

- Keep canned food in a cool, dry place.
- Store boxed food in tightly closed plastic or metal containers.
- Replace expired items as needed.
- Re-think your needs every year and update your kit as your family's needs change.

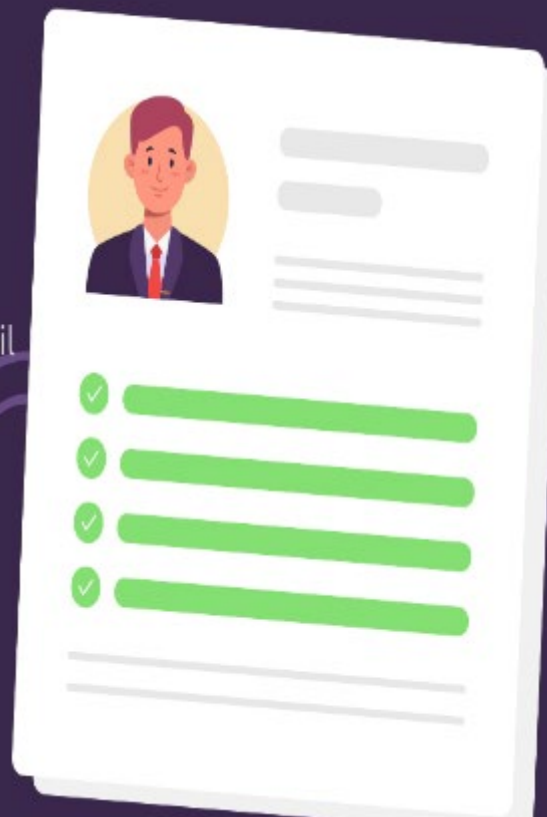
