Suspicious Activity Indicators Where We Live, Work, and Play!



EXPRESSED OR IMPLIED THREAT

Threatening to commit a crime that could harm or kill people or damage a facility, infrastructure, or secured site



PHOTOGRAPHY/SURVEILLANCE

Taking pictures or videos, or a prolonged interest in personnel, facilities, security features, or infrastructure in an unusual or covert manner



THEFT/LOSS/DIVERSION

Stealing or diverting items—such as equipment, uniforms, or badges—that belong to a facility or secured site



TESTING OR PROBING OF SECURITY

Investigating or testing a facility's security or IT systems to assess the strength or weakness of the target



AVIATION ACTIVITY

Operating or interfering with the operation of an aircraft that poses a threat of harm to people and property



BREACH/ATTEMPTED INTRUSION

Unauthorized people trying to enter a restricted area or impersonating authorized personnel



ACQUISITION OF EXPERTISE

Gaining skills or knowledge on a specific topic, such as facility security, military tactics, or flying an aircraft



ELICITING INFORMATION

Questioning personnel beyond mere curiosity about an event, facility, or operations



MISREPRESENTATION

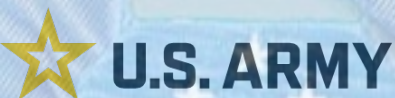

Last year, Fort Johnson rededicated 10 streets in honor of Medal of Honor recipients from Louisiana during Medal of Honor Month.



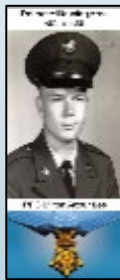

NOAA Weather Radio (NWR) is a nationwide network of radio stations that broadcast continuous weather information from the nearest National Weather Service office based on your physical location.





 - ❖ IPPS-A continues improvements with multiple updates to the Permanent Change of Station (PCS) Order. The updates have added additional information on the PCS Order.
- What is Not Working:
 - ❖ Information and the flow from S-1 to Soldier/Soldier to S-1 and with MPD.
 - ❖ IPPS-A Addendums continue, they are needed to include additional information not already included on the PCS Order.
- Corrective Steps Taken:
 - ❖ Levy Briefing is provided 2x monthly; schedule for 2025 sent to G-1 and each Unit S-1.
 - ❖ Created step by step process for IPPS-A Personal Action Request (PAR) for PCS Orders and Clearing Papers effective 1 February 2024. (Step By Step Slides provided to G-1 and Unit S-1s)
- Assistance needed:
 - ❖ Command awareness/involvement when rosters of assignments are still pending under 90/60/30 days out from report date. Soldiers need Orders but they can't be completed until the Soldier/Unit completes their requirements.

- Fort Johnson phased in the Global Household Goods Contract (GHC) 02 Dec 2024
 - Each Service Member must be screened **upon receiving orders** to determine if they will move under GHC or the legacy system (DPS)
 - A Sort Tool located on the DPS landing page asks a series of questions to make the determination and way forward
 - All GHC customers will receive Face-to-Face counseling
- Peak Season is swiftly approaching – ensure you visit the transportation office as soon as you **receive your orders**
At All Times
- Have a back up plan (releasing agent, PPM, report date deferment, etc.)
- Be flexible
- If experiencing any issues with your shipment, immediately contact the transportation office so we can troubleshoot your situation sooner rather than later

PCS Season and Housing:

PCS season will be here soon and there are some important steps we would like to remind everyone:

- We require notice in writing at least 30 days prior to moving out of the home. Hard orders are not required to be put on notice. Those can be collected prior to the final move out inspection. Put your notice in as soon as possible to avoid insufficient notice fees.
- As with Transportation, our schedule fills up quickly as we can only conduct so many inspections a day. Get your notice in and move out date secured as soon as possible to align with all your travel plans, HHG shipment and report dates.
- A Move Out Guide is available on the Resident Portal with reminders and tips on how to navigate thru a PCS as smoothly as possible.
- Don't forget to provide a forwarding address to USPS as well as update your address with any delivery services such as Amazon, Walmart, Chewy, etc. Corvias is unable to forward any mail or packages delivered after a resident has moved out. That must be handled thru the USPS or merchant the item(s) were purchased thru.

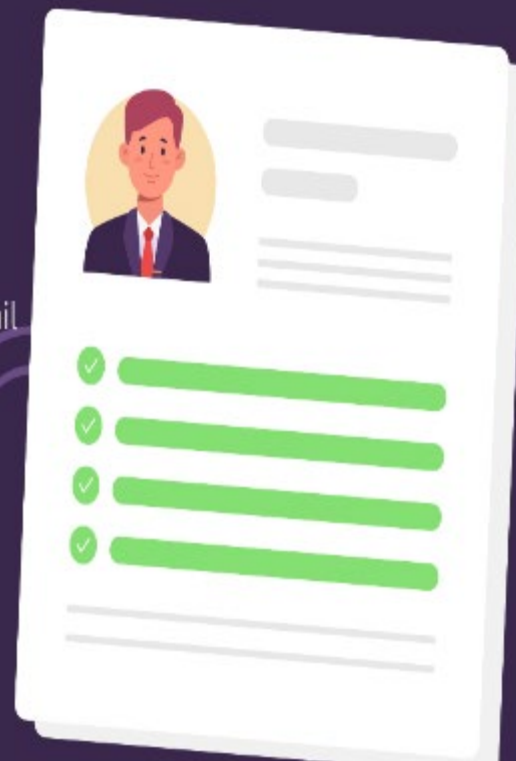

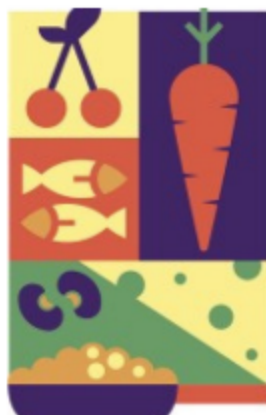
