Fort Polk extends public comment period on trespass horse environmental assessment

FORT POLK, Louisiana - The Joint Readiness Training Center commanding general has extended the public comment period on the Environmental Assessment (EA) and draft Finding of No Significant Impacts (FNSI) concerning the disposition of trespass horses at Fort Polk.

Fort Polk has been informed that some members of the public may be having difficulty submitting comments via email; specifically from Hughes.net email addresses.

While email is not the only available method to submit a comment, in order to ensure that all members of the public have ample opportunity to submit a comment, Fort Polk will extend the public comment period by 15 days, with a new end date of June 17.
