🔆 ^{U.S. ARMY} Weather Terms and Monitoring Tools

- <u>Severe Thunderstorm Watch:</u> is when the atmosphere is favorable for the development of severe thunderstorms. Watch the sky and monitor Fort Johnson Social Media sites, stay tuned to NOAA Weather Radio, and commercial radio or television for more information.
- Severe Thunderstorm Warning: is when severe weather has been reported by spotters or indicated by radar. Warnings indicate imminent danger to life and property to those in the path of the storm.
- <u>Tornado Watch:</u> is when weather conditions in an area indicate an increased risk for severe weather that may be capable of producing a tornado.
- <u>Tornado Warning</u>: is when a tornado has been sighted or indicated by weather radar. A warning means you should take shelter immediately.

CEL Survey's

First, we would like to thank everyone that participated in the survey we are going to share some of the good news and what we will continue to work on.

Good News

- Response Rate was higher this year by 9.5% compared to prior year.
- Overall Level of Satisfaction increased by 1.9% compared to prior year.
- Property and Service Satisfaction increased by a combined average of 1.5% compared to prior year.

Continuing to Work On

- Sidewalks and Roads. Even thought we have started the repair of some roads in the Maple and Dogwood area we will continue our efforts to identify areas of needing repair.
- Landscaping. Continue to remove all dead trees around family housing and work with the landscaper to ensure quality of service is maintained with inspections.
- Condition of homes. Continue to have meetings to find ways to improve the condition of the homes in hopes to increase customer service and provide the best homes possible.

Home Winterization

- Our winterization process for all Vacant Units includes ensuring the heat is set to a minimum of 65 degrees.
- · Opening of all cabinet doors to assist with airflow and temperatures around water mains, valves, and drains
- And during extended freezing temperatures: the dripping of water from all fixtures.
- For our occupied spaces, we send out multiple E-Blasts with all of the above information, but also including the disconnecting of hoses at exterior spigots.
- Requesting all Service Members that will be going on leave to sign up for our Home Watch Program.
 - This gives us the ability to enter their home, perform all of the necessary preparations and the ability to follow up on those spaces as needed for monitoring.
- The awareness that the space is currently "unoccupied" greatly increases our success in freeze prevention; reducing the opportunity for flooding to impact our Customers homes and belongings overall.
