MEMORANDUM FOR Director, Directorate of Operations, United States Army  
Garrison-Redstone, Redstone Arsenal, AL 35898

SUBJECT: Delegation of Authority

1. Reference. Army Regulation 190-56, The Army Civilian Police and Security Guard Program, 15 March 2013.

2. Pursuant to my authority as Commander, United States Army Garrison-Redstone, I designate and authorize the Director of Operations (DO) to perform law and order, enforcement of fish and game laws, and the security and force protection missions on Redstone Arsenal, Alabama.

3. I specifically delegate to the DO all authority, responsibility, and empowerment consistent with United States (U.S.) laws and regulations to:

a. Further delegate to the Chief, Law Enforcement Division, the empowerment necessary to enforce all statutes, laws, regulations, and other applicable directives on Redstone Arsenal, Alabama. This responsibility includes:

(1) The selection, employment, in-service training, certification, management and supervision of Department of the Army Civilian Police (DACP) (job series 0083) and Game Conservation Law Enforcement personnel (job series 1801), and the issuance of procedures, guidance, instructions, and directives, which define the scope of their law enforcement authority (persons, places, and offenses within their jurisdiction).

(2) The establishment of written procedures for notifying each DACP and Game Conservation officer of the extent of their authority and procedures for suspending and withdrawing their authority.

b. Further delegate to the Chief, Physical Security Division, the empowerment necessary to perform security duties and detain individuals suspected of violating statutes, laws, regulations, and other applicable directives on Redstone Arsenal, Alabama. This responsibility includes:

(1) The selection, employment, in-service training, certification, management and supervision of Department of the Army Security Guard (DASG) (job series 0085)

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personnel, and the issuance of procedures, guidance, instructions, and directives, which define the scope of DASG authority.

(2) The establishment of written procedures for notifying each DASG of the extent of their authority and procedures for suspending and withdrawing their authority.

4. DASG are not authorized to perform law enforcement functions. There is necessarily a very limited overlap in the activities performed by DASG and law enforcement personnel, such as the limited authority to detain persons and the use of deadly force in accordance with regulation and policy.

5. The DO will coordinate all delegations, policies, and procedures concerning authority and jurisdiction with the Redstone Arsenal Staff Judge Advocate and other offices as appropriate. All such policies and procedures will be reviewed at least every two years for adequacy and legal sufficiency.
