SUBJECT: Risk Assessments

1. Reference: DA PAM 385-30 (Risk Management), 2 Dec 2014

2. The risk assessment process ensures the safety and wellbeing of people, prevents the loss of or damage to equipment and aids in protecting the environment.

3. Redstone Arsenal events that involve Garrison support or I have a "need to know about" require a Deliberate Risk Acceptance Worksheet (DRAW – DA Form 2977).

4. Examples include the Oktoberfest, JROTC competitions, Retiree Appreciation Day, running and bicycle races, AMC, NASA and Program Executive Office (PEO) community events.

5. All DRAWs are first sent to the Garrison Safety Office (GSO) for review and technical comment. The GSO will ensure proper processing through the Garrison staff.

6. As Garrison Commander, I have risk acceptance authority for LOW and MEDIUM risks and can approve a HIGH risk for a one month duration or less.

7. The Deputy to the Garrison Commander has the same risk level authority and will sign a DRAW in my absence.

8. Prior event planning and staff coordination will help reduce hazards to an acceptable level of risk and thus ensure a safe and seamless event or activity.
