
PLEASE NOTE

- Road conditions reflect on post circumstances only, however, they can be an indicator of existing road conditions outside the installation.
- ✓ In Baumholder, the garrison commander, in coordination with the garrison manager, determine work delays, early dismissals and closures.
- ✓ In the Kaiserslautern Military Community, Army and Air Force commanders in coordination with DODEA make coordinated school closure decisions. Late reporting and/or closure decisions are made as early as possible.

SCHOOLS

- ✓ All DODEA schools will take the same action (early closure, late reporting, or cancellation).
- ✓ Early release, late reporting and/or closure decisions are made as early as possible.
- School buses often have difficulty transiting some areas and low temperature may be dangerous to children waiting at bus stops. Please plan accordingly to allow for adequate time to complete notifications and ensure school bus accommodations are made.




