- **Soldiers for Life** - our Retirees and Veterans whose service we honor and ask that they continue their mission to hire fellow veterans and inspire young Americans to serve.

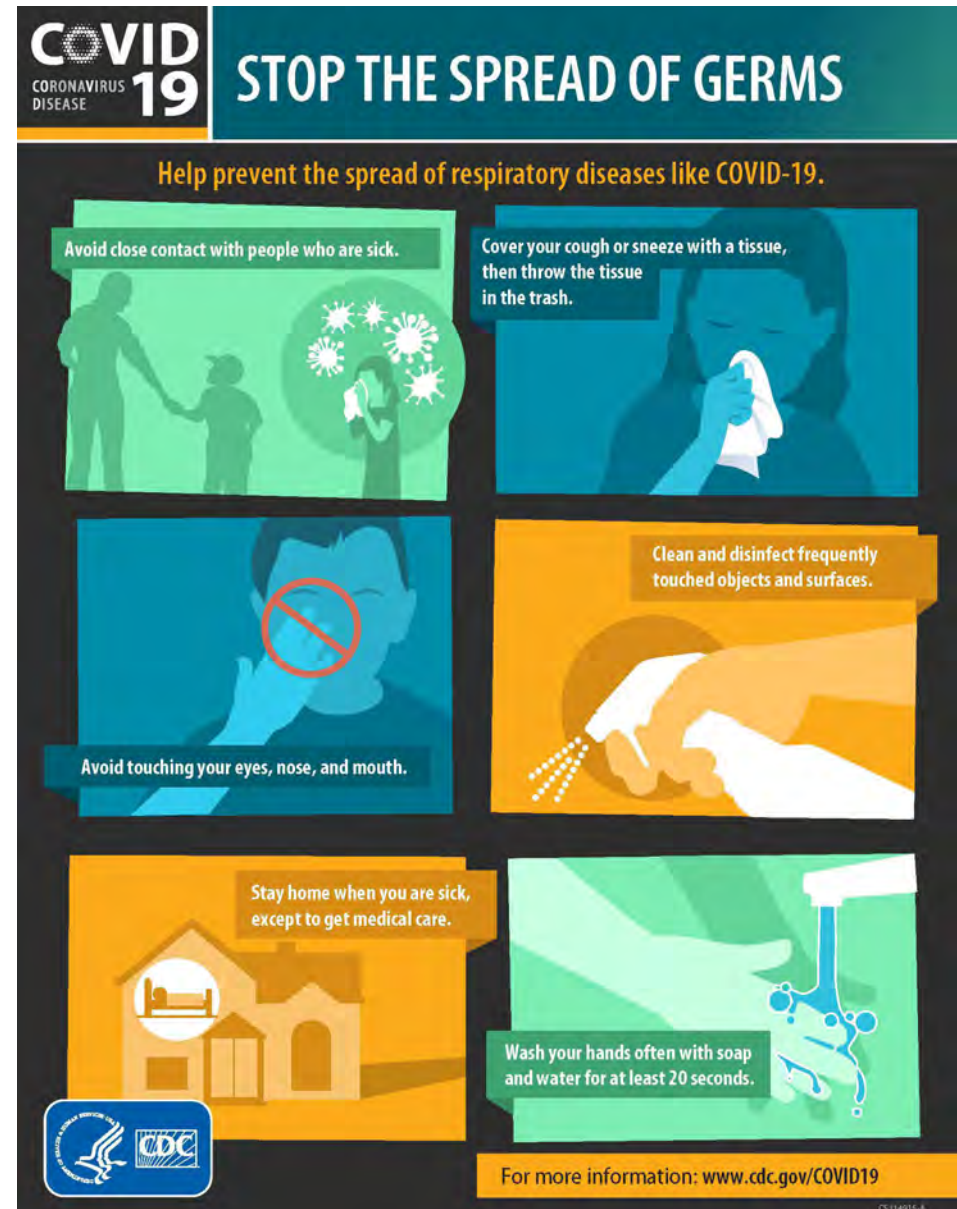

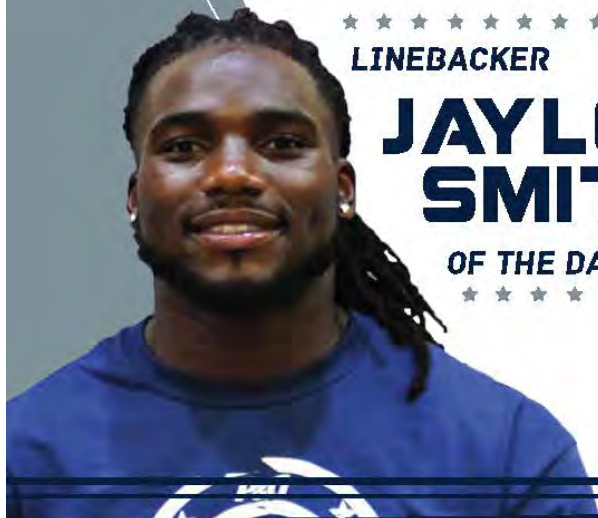
