FACTS:

- Opened on 19 February 2003
- Jointly operated by the City of Kaiserslautern, the 86th Airlift Wing and the United States Army Garrison Rheinland-Pfalz (USAG RP)
- · Bi-lingual staff
- Since 2003, almost 40,000 customers personal inquiries (local, national & international) either via telephone, in person, or in writing (email, "snail mail") (U.S. citizens = 53%, Germans = 44% and other nations = 3%) In addition, nearly 25,000 during the weekly USO newcomers orientations for US Army Soldiers and their families.
- On average, nearly 3,000 inquiries per year (well over 200 per month)
- GREAT VALUE!!! LOW COST to U.S. government (no lease/rent cost, no utilities cost, etc. just telecommunications (approx. 200 Euros per month) and "our") labor)









- General linguistic support: (e.g. assistance in solving contractual issues, if possible, hands on and on the spot)
- Assistance to enable smooth transition with change of status (e.g. local retirement (European Out) or loss of SOFA status, etc.) by providing pertinent information on pertinent requirements
- Assistance with administrative issues (e.g. assistance with German authorities, visa questions, etc.)
- Mediation to avoid possible court cases (e.g. chimney sweep, noise, pet issues, neighborhood queries)
- Provide information on host nation policies and regulations (e.g. recycling, rules on driving, pet keeping, etc.)
- Help U.S./German citizens/U.S. veterans widows/widowers to remain in Germany
- Facilitate and help establish official and family contacts

- **2. Education Center:** Services: Counseling; Tuition Assistance; Army Personnel Testing; Credentialing Assistance; Basic Skills Education Program (GT Score Improvement); ASVAB; Career Exploration Program for DoDEA high schools. **(In-Person College Courses):** UMGC, CTC, ERAU, OU. **Locations**: Sembach, ROB, Landstuhl, and Baumholder.
- **3. Transition Assistance Program (TAP):** TAP is a congressionally mandated program for all transitioning Soldiers that helps them prepare for their post-military career. All service members must start TAP NLT 365 days prior to expiration of Term of Service (ETS) or retirement date (*may start TAP up to 18 months before ETS or 24 months before retirement*).
- **4. Total Army Sponsorship Program (TASP):** The Total Army Sponsorship Program is a commander's program. The commander is responsible for its implementation, leadership involvement and its success. The USAG-RP DHR Installation Sponsorship Liaison & ACS Relocation Readiness Program Manager are the POCs for training, assistance and resources.

5. Army Substance Abuse Program (ASAP):

- The Unit Risk Inventory (URI) is an anonymous 77 question survey which provides a picture of a unit's self-reported high-risk behaviors. USAREUR-AF units are required to conduct URIs at least once every 12 months.
- The Army Substance Abuse Program/Rheinland-Pfalz (ASAP/RP) conducts national awareness campaigns, such as Red Ribbon Week, to mobilize the RP community to educate youth and spread awareness about illicit drug use. Throughout October, ASAP will engage in school visits and community outreach events to increase knowledge and encourage students and parents to sign drug free pledges.

Department of Defense Child Care Program Priorities

The policy, <u>signed</u> 21 Feb 2020, by <u>Secretary of Defense Mark Esper</u>, implemented a policy change to priorities for childcare.

The DoD's waitlist management system, MilitaryChildCare.com, is the access point for all waitlist requests. <u>These changes</u> <u>were effective beginning</u> <u>1 Sep 2020.</u>

Potential for Displacement: When there is a waitlist for high priority categories exceed our capacity, lower priorities are displaced with a 45-day notice.



Home Based Business (HBB) on Army Installations

HBB Establishment Steps

- 1. Submit Application Packet to Liaison Office:
 - a) Application with Formal Business Proposal attached
 - b) AEF 210-70A Certificate of Understanding
 - c) AEF 210-70B Statement of Understanding
 - d) Copy of Passport with SOFA stamp and copy of ID card
 - e) Approved HBB Memorandum from Housing
 - f) Documents can be found at: <u>https://kaiserslautern.armymwr.com/programs/home-based-business</u>
 - g) HBB owner needs to register the business at German Trade Office for a Tax ID. They are also encouraged to engage legal advisors and contact customs office as they need to comply with German tax laws.
- 2. Packet is submitted for Legal Review and Garrison Commander Approval by PO Liaison.
- 3. Written Approval is provided to HBB owner after favorable legal review and Garrison Commander approval has been received.

Private Organizations (PO) on Army Installations

PO Establishment

- 1. Submit valid documents to PO Liaison Office:
 - a) USAG RP Application
 - b) Constitution and Bylaws (Must include the articles of agreement listed in AR 210-22)
 - c) Officer Listing (Include address, phone number email and SOFA status)
 - d) SOFA Status Memo (51% of members must have SOFA status)
 - e) Valid Proof of Insurance
 - f) Request to establish a bank account with IRS SS-4 document
- 2. Packet is submitted for Legal Review by PO Liaison.
- 3. Written Approval from Director, Family and MWR is provided to Private Organization POC after favorable legal review is received.

POs requesting space must initiate a space request through the USAG-RP Plans, Analysis, and Integration Office to pursue a real estate license or agreement if space is available.

Fundraisers on Army Installations

Fundraiser Submission Approval Process for approved Private Organizations, Informal Funds (units), or Soldier Family Readiness Groups

- 1. Fundraiser Requests should be submitted a minimum of 30 days before the event date to PO Liaison Office (PO's must have current approval to operate and be current on insurance it can't be lapsed):
 - a) Event Application
 - b) Valid Food Handler Card (if food is involved at fundraiser)
 - c) PO is limited to 12 Fundraisers/FY
- 2. Packet is submitted for Legal Review by PO Liaison.
- Written Letter of Approval from Director, Family and MWR is provided to POC after favorable legal review is received, reflecting the number of fundraisers remaining for the FY.



Army Stationing Installation Plan (ASIP)

Regulatory Guidance: AR 5-18 (5 August 2022)

- Paragraph 1-14. Commanders of Army commands, Army service component commands, and direct reporting units; senior commanders; and installation/garrison commanders will -
 - Review the ASIP installation report quarterly. Within 60 days of receipt of the report, provide recommended changes through appropriate channels to the HQDA proponent for inclusion in the source databases (such as SAMAS, DRRS – A, FMSWEB, ATRRS, ARNG, and USAR unit locations). Provide an information copy of these submissions to DCS, G – 9 (DAIN – ODR).
 - 2. Report improperly identified or undocumented derivative units' strength (officer, warrant officer, enlisted, and civilian) and location to the DCS, G 9 (DAIN ODR) for inclusion in the ASIP.
 - 3. Report improperly identified or undocumented derivative units' changes to appropriate channels to update ASIP data in DRRS A and FMSWEB.
 - 4. Submit report on transient training data (not including ATRRS training) for inclusion in the ASIP to DCS, G 9 (DAIN ODR).
 - 5. Designate an ASIP point of contact (POC) and provide the POC name, position, and phone number to the DCS, G-9.
 - Your FORCE MANAGER is most likely going to be your POC, and needs to understand this responsibility.

Key Takeaway. IMCOM is no longer the lead agency for ASIP integrity. It is the responsibility of every unit Commander (at levels stated above) to self-report, identify discrepancies, and provide revisions to HQDA (DCS G-9).

DRSS-A is one method of communicating these revisions/discrepancies to HQDA

Why you should care. ASIP directly feeds the Real-Property Planning and Analysis System (RPLANS) database, which ensures proper funding for the maintenance and renovations of your facilities!
