## Garrison Commander's Opening Comments

## Why is a sound Sponsorship Program so important?

A comprehensive Total Army Sponsorship Program (TASP) WILL;

- Increase readiness and resiliency for Units, Soldiers, and Families
- Build trust between inbound Personnel (and Families) and their new unit (and community)
- Assist with managing the expectations of inbound Personnel/Families
- Ensure a smoother PCS process
- Provide engaged leaders with the opportunity to
  - Reduce risk
  - Reduce stress
  - Reduce negative behaviors/actions
  - Save resources, such as time and money
- Support the prevention of suicide, sexual assault, substance misuse, and domestic violence



### How to sabotage the program

### Units without a comprehensive TASP WILL;

- Risk unpreparedness due to compromised readiness/resiliency
- Experience a lack of cohesion and teamwork
- Extend the amount of time it takes to in-process
- By default, create a chaotic and poorly executed PCS experience
- Observe the following consequences;
  - Increased enrollment in punitive/rehabilitative programs
  - Increased accident/incident rate
  - A lack of respect for standards/protocols
  - Wasted time, funds, opportunities
- Fail to prevention of suicide, sexual assault, substance misuse, and domestic violence





### The TASP cannot succeed without Command emphasis

How NOT to represent the intent of the TASP;

- Do NOT misinterpret Sponsorship as an unnecessary luxury
- Do NOT assume that, since Soldiers are adults, each will figure things out independently
- Do NOT assume a Soldier can wait a couple of hours at the Gateway – that they'll be okay
- Soldiers should NOT in-process the unit COMPLETELY before working on the installation checklist
- Anyone CANNOT pick a Soldier up from the airport and deliver him or her to TLA or the barracks. How this is done, or who performs the task, is important.
- Do NOT assume that if all the blocks are checked, no red flags will go up
- Do NOT assume that taking care of our own OUR way is enough.





## Army Family Housing (AFH) Plane to Pillow Program

Plane to Pillow is a Department of the Army program to facilitate direct housing and a smoother PCS for incoming Soldiers and Families

- Inbound families are encouraged to use the "advanced application" for housing.
   PCS orders, leave forms, data verification are requested by 60 days before arrival
- 2. Unit sponsorship is CRUCIAL to making this process work
- 3. Unit sponsors are encouraged to engage consistently with Housing as they are assigned Families
- 4. Provide organizational email address and send inquiries and documents to Housing










## Plans, Analysis & Integration Office (PAIO-Stationing)



- □ Population Growth: 5,489 Soldiers, Civilians, and Family Members (Thru-FY26)
  - Transform KMC to accommodate ARSTRUC Growth: ~2,460 SM, CIV, and FM
    - Renovate maintenance facility on Miesau
    - Revitalize Pulaski Barracks future centralized community center
    - Renovate select facilities on Kleber Kaserne
    - Enables additional barracks, administrative, and maintenance facilities to address deficits
- Barracks: 2x barracks renovation projects programed in KMC to add additional barracks capacity
  - B-210 (Sembach) adds ~300 barracks rooms; construction starts FY24-26
  - B-3210 (Kleber) adds ~288 barracks rooms; anticipate construction will start FY28; must relocate all tenant organizations out of B-3210 before initiating barracks project
    - Tied to Pulaski Barracks critical event mile-stone or "Domino Project"
  - SM required to "double-up" in existing barracks in KMC footprint
  - EMH (barracks system of record) updates are critical
    - Provides DPW Housing with capability to identify vacant rooms

# Physicals Preparing for Youth Sports

- Child and Youth Services (CYS) requires children of all ages enrolled in CYS Sports and Fitness programs to have a Sports Physical completed by the parent and a Licensed Independent Practitioner (LIP).
- The physical is considered valid for 12 months from the date and signature of the LIP. Physicals must be valid for the duration of the program that the child or youth is registered for.

- A second rodeo will be conducted at the end of August (DTG TBD).

# What are the requirements to open a Community Bank Account?

- To be eligible for full banking services at Community Bank, you must meet at least one of the requirements below:
- Active duty U.S. Military, stationed in a country serviced by Community Bank
- A DOD civilian employee who is a U.S. citizen, residing in a country serviced by Community Bank
- A U.S. citizen who is an employee of all other U.S. Government departments, agencies, and Non-appropriated Fund Instrumentalities
  carrying on functions on a DOD installation in a country serviced by Community Bank
- An authorized family member of such military or civilian employee listed above
- In addition, DOD Component Commands may approve banking services for other individuals when they qualify for individual logistic support
  under regulations of the appropriate military service which is not precluded by Status of Forces Agreement (SOFA), other intergovernmental
  agreements, or hosting country or local law.
