

1. Travel within Host Nation.

a. The local leave and pass area is currently deemed to include the entire area inside the host nation's borders. This means as a baseline measure, leave, pass, or other unofficial travel by Service Members inside their resident host nation's borders is authorized.

b. Subordinate commanders retain the discretion to impose more restrictive leave and pass policies.

2. International Travel. All international travel must be accordance with the "USAREUR Leave, Pass, and TDY Flowchart Official and Unofficial Travel Guidance". Due to rapidly changing conditions, all individuals must remain aware of the possibility that countries may impose quarantines, close borders, or otherwise restrict movement with little or no warning, during their travel or upon return.
