






New Multipurpose Courts Examples









Germany Ongoing Protests

USAG-RP Inclement Weather Guide

PLEASE NOTE

- ✓ Road conditions reflect on post circumstances only, however, they
 can be an indicator of existing road conditions outside the
 installation.
- In Baumholder, the garrison commander, in coordination with the garrison manager, determine work delays, early dismissals and closures.
- ✓ In the Kaiserslautern Military Community, Army and Air Force commanders in coordination with DODEA make coordinated school closure decisions. Late reporting and/or closure decisions are made as early as possible.

SCHOOLS

- ✓ All DODEA schools will take the same action (early closure, late reporting, or cancellation).
- ✓ Early release, late reporting and/or closure decisions are made as early as possible.
- School buses often have difficulty transiting some areas and low temperature may be dangerous to children waiting at bus stops. Please plan accordingly to allow for adequate time to complete notifications and ensure school bus accommodations are made.

AMBER: Road conditions are normal to dangerous.
Drivers should exercise precautions. Most installation operations and services should be open, but changes in weather could lead to late reporting or early release.

RED: Road conditions are hazardous. GOV use off installation is limited to emergency and mission essential driving; POV use is discouraged. Late reporting or early release and closure of services is probable for non mission essential personnel.

BLACK: Road conditions are hazardous to extremely hazardous. GOV use off installation is at the discretion of the owning commander; POVs should not be on the road. Installation Commander will assess need to close, release or delay.

Road conditions at amber, red and/or black may result in operational delays, early releases and/or closures.



- 3. FMWR Tows Vehicle to Impound Lots (> 72 hrs.)
- 4. Official Notification (120 Days)
- 5. Disposition Board
- 6. Customs
- 7. De-Registered
- 8. FMWR Takes Possession
- 9. New Garrison Policy
 - The costs associated with the towing of abandoned vehicles will be charged to the service member's unit

Installation Passes

All non-DoD ID cardholders who request access to a U.S. military installation are required to either be escorted by a DoD ID cardholder at all times, be on an approved access roster, or be issued an installation pass. All installation passes must be requested on **AE Form 190-16A** by a DoD ID cardholder

Applicants will need to bring the following original documents with them: Ausweiss or passport,

1. SHORT TERM (3 DAYS OR LESS)

DoD ID cardholders age 18 or over that have sign in privileges may sign in up to four visitors at a time at the installation gates.

REQ DOCS: Only Passport or German ID for LN.

SPONSOR: Always required

2. INSTALLATION PASSES FOR VISITING FAMILY MEMBERS (30-90 days) No longer than 6mo. WETP

In accordance with AE Regulation 190-16, family members visiting DoD ID cardholders stationed in U.S. Army Europe may only be issued an installation pass for immediate family members:

REQ DOCS: Passport, NCIC Background Check and flight itinerary.

SPONSOR: Required until pass is approved

3. UNESCORTED PASS. Same as above

REQ DOCS: Passport, NCIC Background Check and flight itinerary.

SPONSOR: Required until pass is approved

ELIGIBLE VETERAN ACCESS (NEW AS OF JANUARY 2020)

Access roster requests (AE Form 190-16F) must be sent via encrypted e-mail from an official e-mail account at least three business days prior to the date of requested access.

What are the requirements to open a Community Bank Account?

To be eligible for full banking services at Community Bank, you must meet at least one of the requirements below:

- Active-duty U.S. Military, stationed in a country serviced by Community Bank
- A DOD civilian employee who is a U.S. citizen, residing in a country serviced by Community Bank
- A U.S. citizen who is an employee of all other U.S. Government departments, agencies, and Non– appropriated Fund Instrumentalities carrying on functions on a DOD installation in a country serviced by Community Bank
- An authorized family member of such military or civilian employee listed above
- In addition, DOD Component Commands may approve banking services for other individuals when they
 qualify for individual logistic support under regulations of the appropriate military service which is not
 precluded by Status of Forces Agreement (SOFA), other intergovernmental agreements, or hosting
 country or local law.

- 1. Army Continuing Education System (ACES). ACES provides Counseling; Tuition Assistance; Army Personnel Testing; Credentialing Assistance; Basic Skills Education Program (GT Score Improvement); National Testing Centers; ASVAB for Recruiting Services; ASVAB Career Exploration Program for DoDEA high schools. (In-Person College Courses): ERAU & UMGC. Locations: Sembach, ROB, Landstuhl, and Baumholder (Ed center Clinic Kaserne Bldg 8745, Baumholder Army Personnel Testing Smith Barracks Bldg 8332.
 - a. American Education Week (All Centers): 13-17 Nov 23 (See flyers).
- 2. Transition Assistance Program (TAP). TAP is a congressionally mandated program for all transitioning Soldiers that helps them prepare for their post-military career. All service members must start TAP NLT 365 days prior to expiration of Term of Service (ETS) or retirement date (may start TAP up to 18 months before ETS or 24 months before retirement).
- 3. Career Skills Program (CSP). CSP provides Soldiers the opportunity to participate in skills training programs (such as internships) while still on active duty for an increased probability of employment in high-demand and highly-skills jobs. The Soldier must be within 180 days of separation/retirement, completed TAP requirements and have the commander's approval.
- **4. Total Army Sponsorship Program (TASP).** TASP is a commander's program. The commander is responsible for its implementation, leadership involvement and its success. The USAG-RP DHR Installation Sponsorship Liaison & ACS Relocation Readiness Program Manager are the POCs for training, assistance and resources.
- **5. Army Substance Abuse Program (ASAP).** USAG RP's Army Substance Abuse Program provides the community with suicide prevention education, substance use and alcohol abuse prevention activities, confidential employee assistance counseling, referrals to mental health resources and drug testing services to sustain and enhance resiliency and readiness.

PASSPORTS:

- 1. Customers should renew their passports before they expire, don't wait. Tourist passports have a possible turnaround of up to 6 weeks in normal season.
- 2. Inform yourself with the country of destination's entry requirements, for example: Do I need a VISA? How many months are the minimum requirement for my passport's validity for entry. Obtain country specific entry requirements from the online Foreign Clearance Guide (FCG).
- 3. A SOFA Card is required for family members of Soldiers, authorized civilians and contractors and their Family members, NOT for Service members. Requests for SOFA Card is submitted on AE Form 600-77A, signed by the organization's appointed official (officials are appointed by the organization and the appointment memorandum must be on file at USAG RP Central Processing Facilities Offices in KMC & BMC).

ID CARDS:

- 1. There is no need for ID Card appointments for PIN resets or lost or stolen cards. Walk-ins are welcome, however appointments are priority, so there might be long waiting times.
- 2. ID Card holders can renew their ID Card 30 days before the expiration date and can make an appointment 60 day prior to their expiration date.
- 3. Units are responsible for issuing Ration Cards to Service Members and their Family members.
