Total Army Sponsorship Program (TASP)

Why is a sound Sponsorship Program so important?

A comprehensive Total Army Sponsorship Program (TASP) WILL;

- Increase readiness and resiliency for Units, Soldiers, and Families
- Build trust between inbound Personnel (and Families) and their new unit (and community)
- Assist with managing the expectations of inbound Personnel/Families
- Ensure a smoother PCS process
- Provide engaged leaders with the opportunity to
 - Reduce risk
 - Reduce stress
 - Reduce negative behaviors/actions
 - Save resources, such as time and money
- Support the prevention of suicide, sexual assault, substance misuse, and domestic violence

Total Army Sponsorship Program (TASP)

How to sabotage the program

Units without a comprehensive TASP WILL;

- Risk unpreparedness due to compromised readiness/resiliency
- Experience a lack of cohesion and teamwork
- Extend the amount of time it takes to in-process
- By default, create a chaotic and poorly executed PCS experience
- Observe the following consequences;
 - Increased enrollment in punitive/rehabilitative programs
 - Increased accident/incident rate
 - A lack of respect for standards/protocols
 - Wasted time, funds, opportunities
- Fail to prevention of suicide, sexual assault, substance misuse, and domestic violence



Total Army Sponsorship Program (TASP)

The TASP cannot succeed without Command emphasis

How NOT to represent the intent of the TASP;

- Do NOT misinterpret Sponsorship as an unnecessary luxury
- Do NOT assume that, since Soldiers are adults, each will figure things out independently
- Do NOT assume a Soldier can wait a couple of hours at the Gateway – that they'll be okay
- Soldiers should NOT in-process the unit COMPLETELY before working on the installation checklist
- Anyone CANNOT pick a Soldier up from the airport and deliver him or her to TLA or the barracks. How this is done, or who performs the task, is important.
- Do NOT assume that if all the blocks are checked, no red flags will go up
- Do NOT assume that taking care of our own OUR way is enough.

Total Army Sponsorship Program (TASP)

Army Family Housing (AFH) Plane to Pillow Program

Plane to Pillow is a Department of the Army program to facilitate direct housing and a smoother PCS for incoming Soldiers and Families

1. Inbound families are encouraged to use the “advanced application” for housing. PCS orders, leave forms, data verification are requested by 60 days before arrival
2. **Unit sponsorship** is CRUCIAL to making this process work
3. **Unit sponsors** are encouraged to engage consistently with Housing as they are assigned Families
4. Provide organizational email address and send inquiries and documents to Housing

- ❑ **4QFY23: Multiple activations and inactivation planned.**
- ❑ **Transform KMC to accommodate ARSTRUC growth: ~2,460 SM, CIV, and FM**
 - Renovate maintenance facility on Miesau
 - Revitalize Pulaski Barracks – future Centralized Community Center
 - Renovate select facilities on Kleber Kaserne
 - Enables additional barracks, administrative, and maintenance facilities to address deficits
- ❑ **Challenge: Barracks in support of ARSTRUC growth:**
 - DPW has started adding an additional set of furniture to barracks rooms on Sembach (B-211, 212, and 219).
 - Will start assigning 2 x E1-E4 Soldiers per room. Sembach barracks capable of accommodating 2 x E1-E4 Soldiers per room.
 - All other barracks in KMC are at capacity.
 - Project to renovate barracks B-210 (Sembach) will start FY24-26. Anticipate a gain of 128 rooms.
 - Critical each unit's barracks manager reports accurate information in eMH.

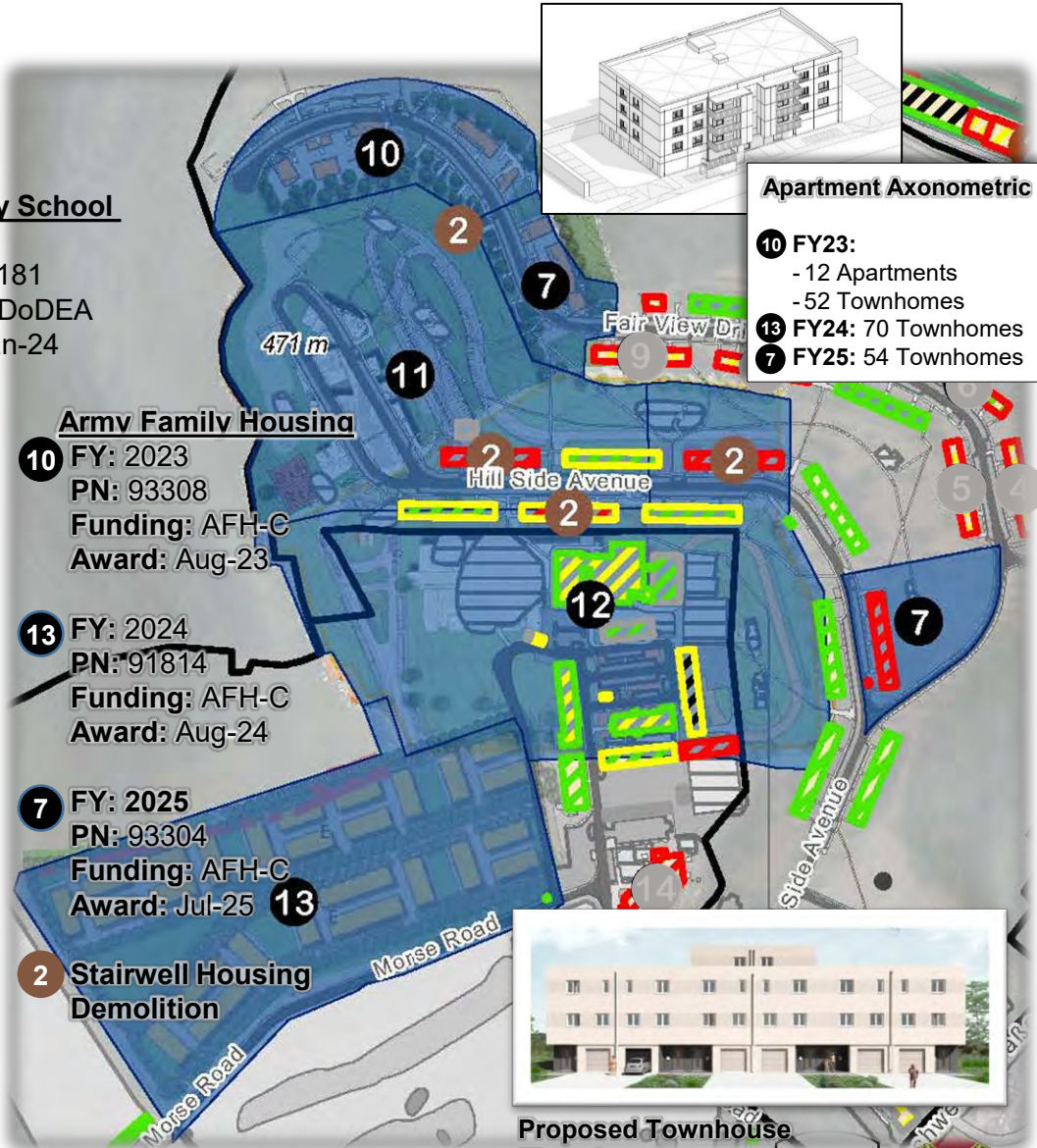
Elementary/Middle-High School Site Layouts



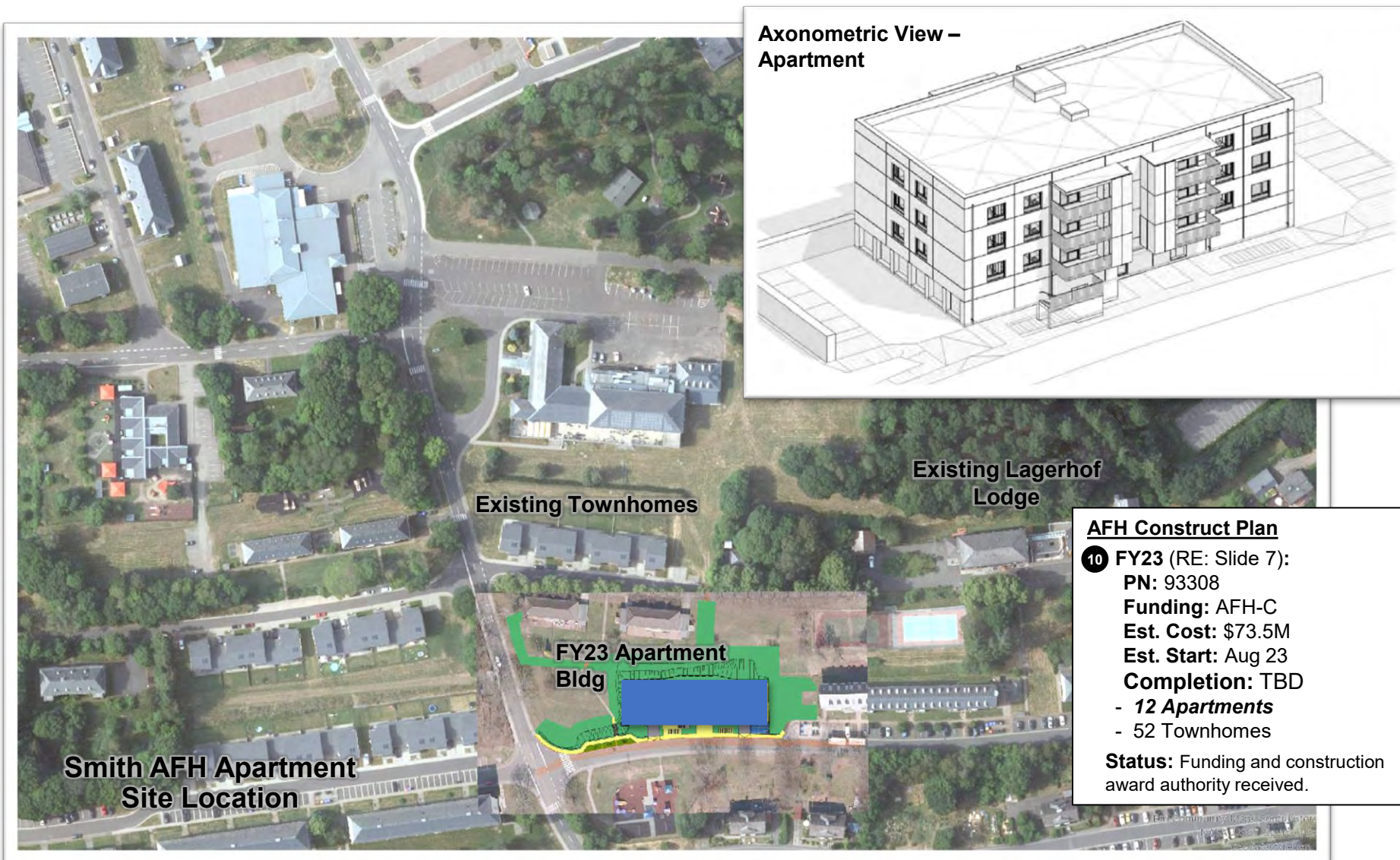

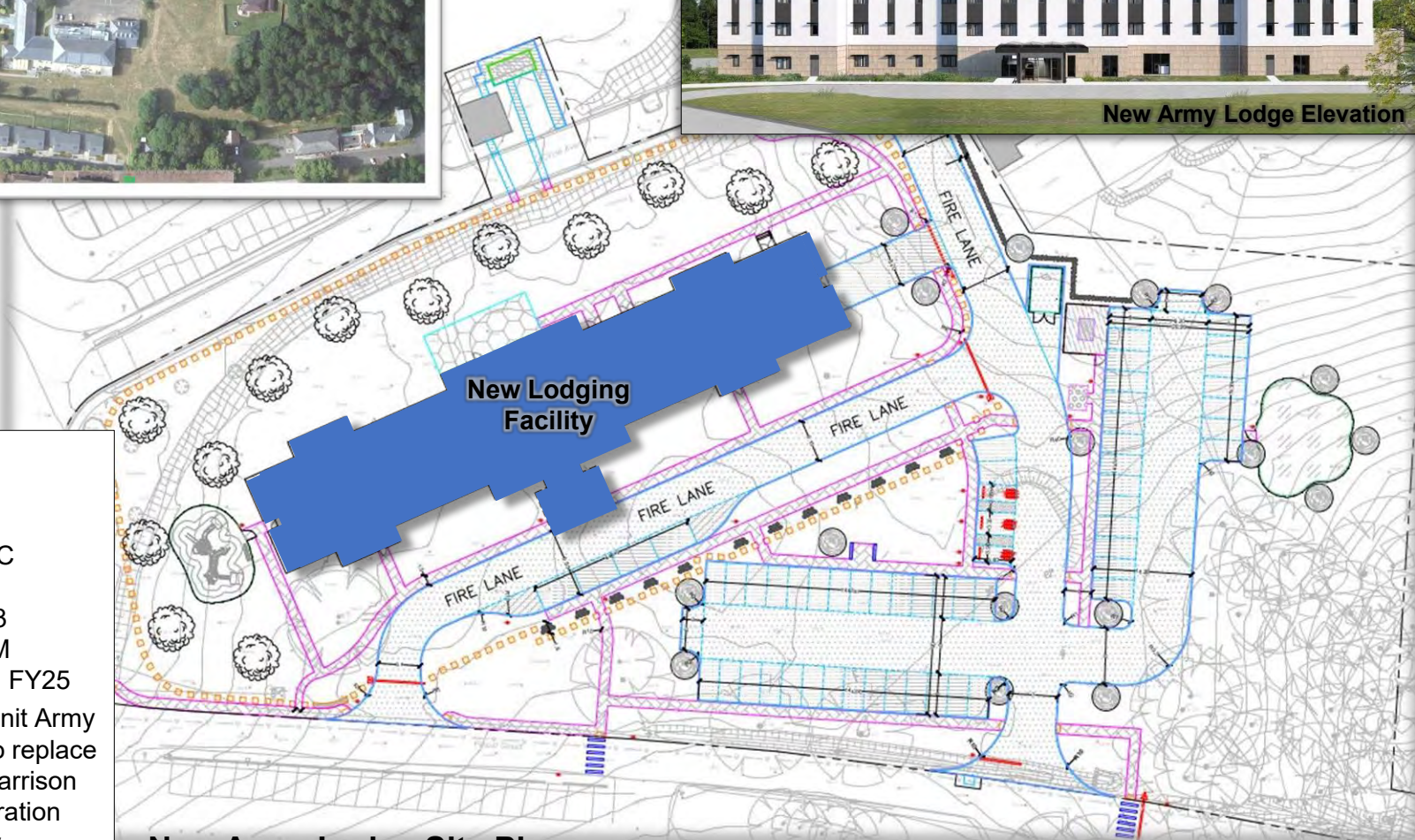

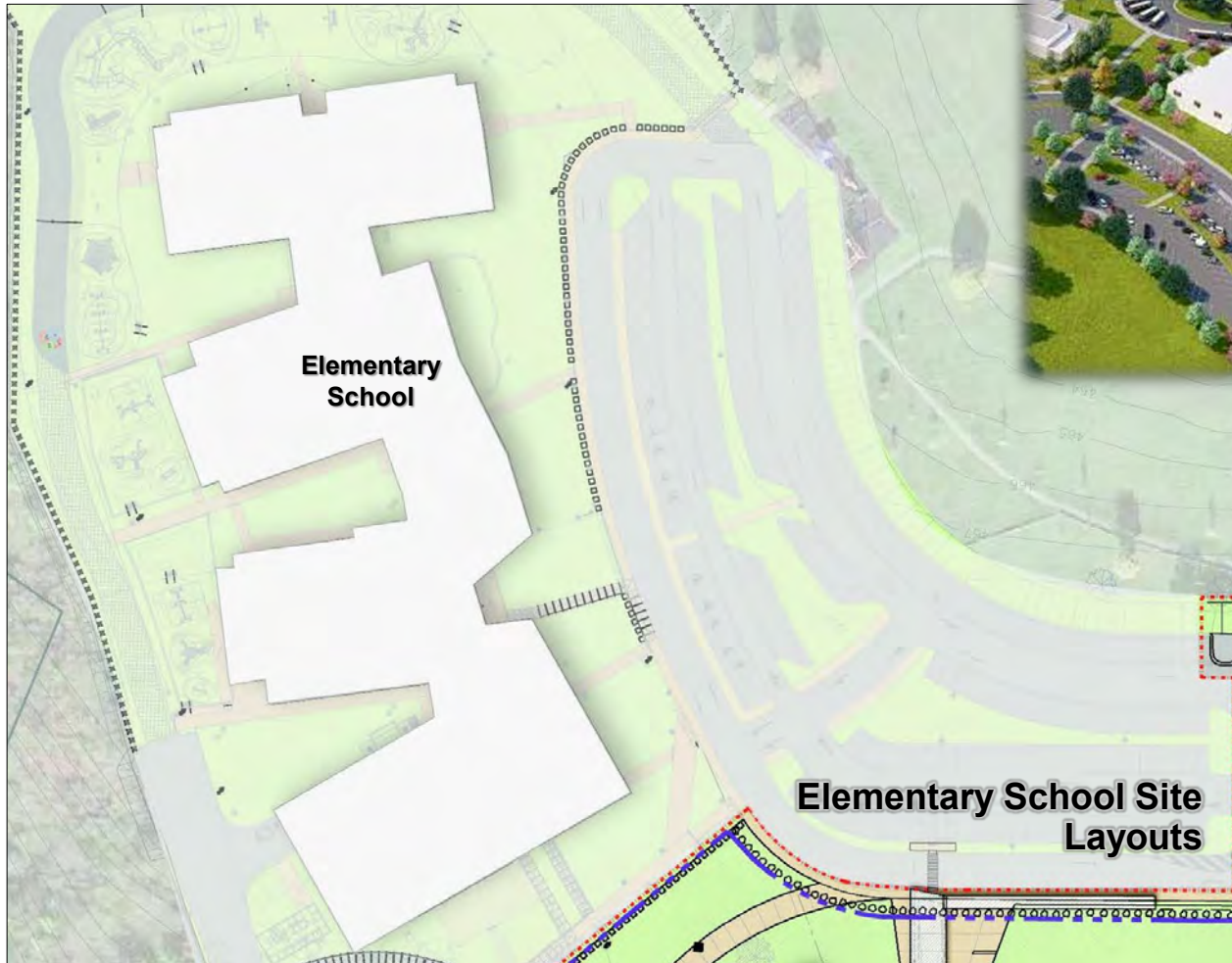

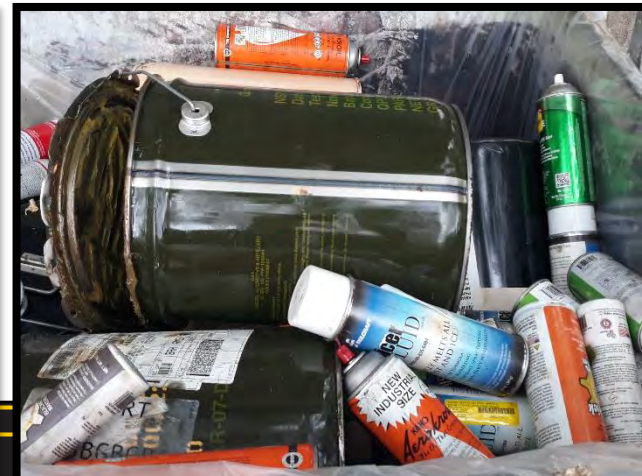

Hazardous Waste (HW) disposal

- Generators of Hazardous Waste are responsible for proper disposal segregation.
- Generators are required to nominate a trained POC that signs for the correctness of HW disposed material.
- Unit signers are liable for accidents based on improper segregation.
- Hazardous Waste shall not be removed if signing POC did not receive the necessary training within 30 days.

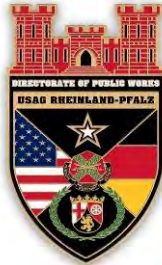

BLUE DART

Quick Reference

The DOD Blue Dart Program rapidly passes specific threat information to permit the targeted unit, organization, or location to respond and reduce the effect of terrorism on personnel, resources, and capabilities.

Blue Dart must include:

- **Target** (Who or Where) / **Threat** (Method of attack) / **TIME** (must happen in 12 hours)

Blue Dart Facts

- Goal is notification with in 10 minutes
- Pass directly to the threatened unit, organization, or location by fastest means possible
- Do not prepare, staff, or coordinate a formal message
 - ✓ Leadership endorsement is NOT required
- The transmission of classified threat information by unsecured means is permitted when necessary
- USAREUR conducts frequent exercises – follow the procedures in the exercise message
- Not all threats occur, but you must be prepared to act
- If in doubt, call the USAG RP IOC at DSN 314-541-3009/3024/3033/3026/3007

Sending/Passing

- Contact targeted unit, organization, or location by fastest means possible
- If no contact, pass info to HHQ
- Follow-up
- Notify your chain of command

Receiving

- Take action immediately to defeat attack or reduce casualties
- Notify your chain of command

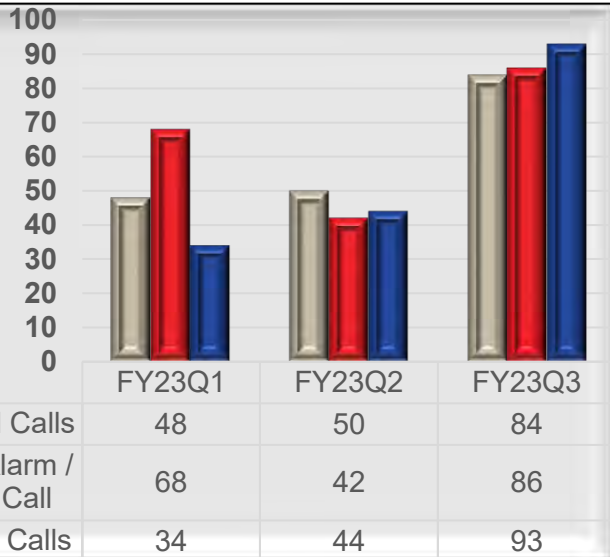

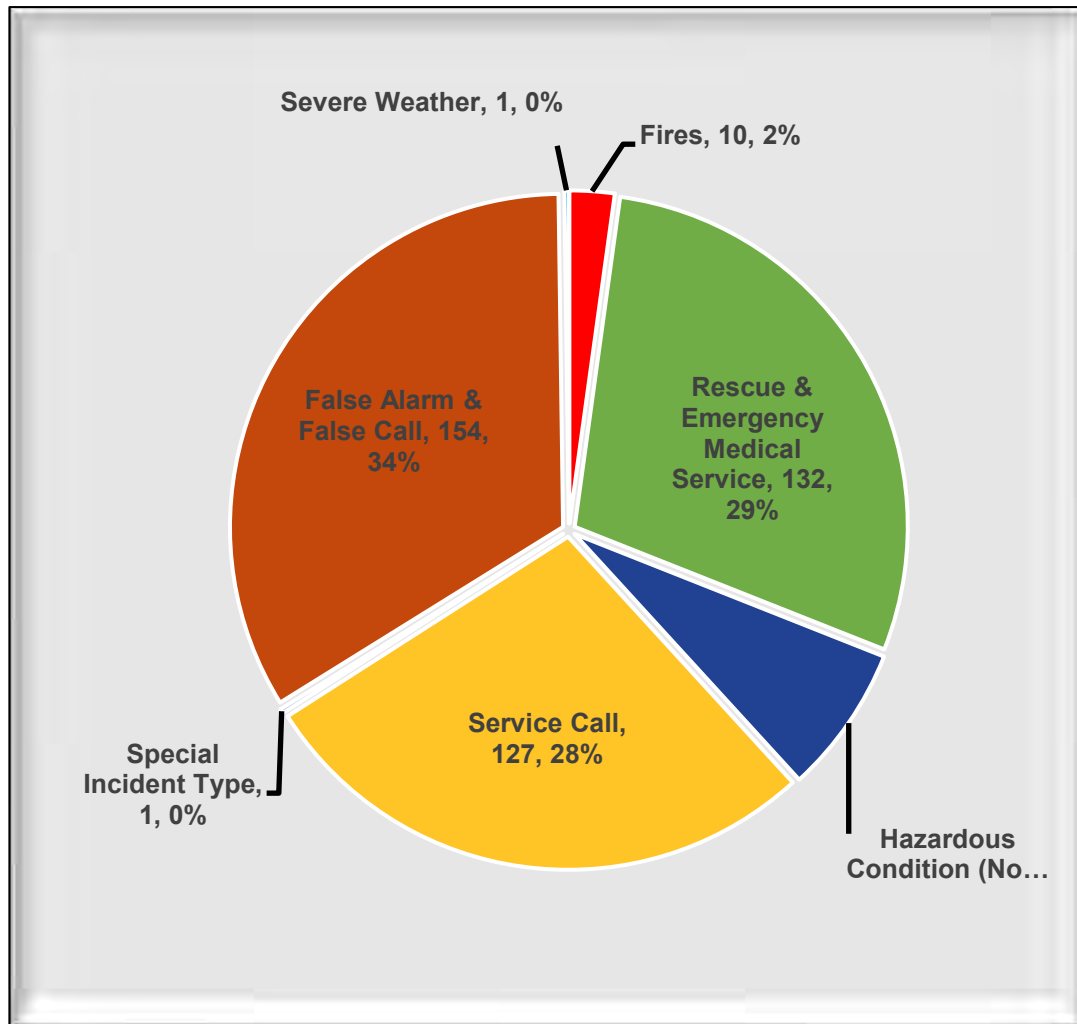

FY23 Fire Emergency Response Trends

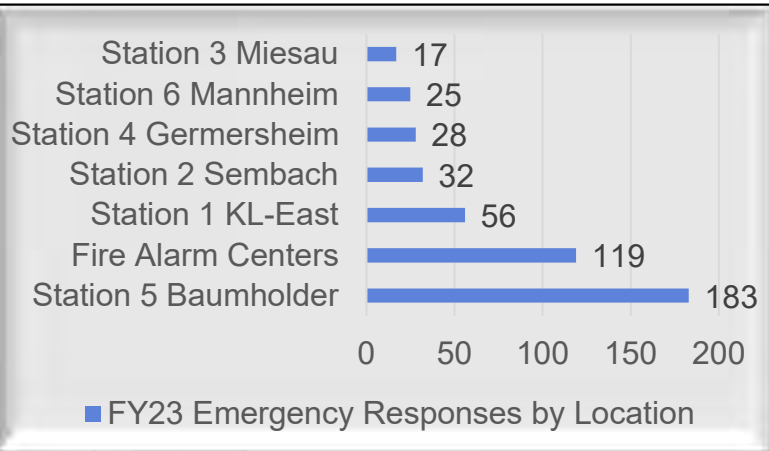
Top 3 Emergency Response Calls for FY23 by Qtr

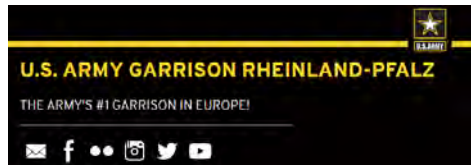
