

# Real ID ACT Implementation

## ATTENTION

State-issued driver's license and identification cards marked, “**Not for Federal Identification, Not for Federal Purposes, Federal Limits May Apply**” or similar wording will require a secondary ID to access Fort Riley. If you do not have a secondary ID you'll be denied unescorted access, or you'll have to be escorted by an adult DoD Sponsor.

**DoD Sponsor:** Uniformed service members or government employees with a valid CAC, a military retiree (with a valid DoD identification credential), or an adult dependent (with a valid DoD identification credential) may serve as a sponsor.

## Acceptable Secondary form of Identification

- Locally issued installation badge and/or pass
- DBIDS Credential
- Birth Certificate (no photo copy)
- U.S. Social Security Card issued by the Social Security Administration
- Border Crossing Card (Form DSP-150)
- Refugee Travel Document (Form I-571)
- Certificate of U.S. Citizenship (Form N-560 or N-561)
- U.S. Certificate of Naturalization or Certificate of Citizenship (form N-550)
- Employment Authorization Document (Form I-766)
- U.S. Citizen ID Card (Form I-197)
- Native American Tribal photo ID
- U.S. Military or draft record
- Foreign Passport with a Temporary (I-551) stamp or temporary (I-551) printed notation on a machine readable Immigrant VISA.
- School ID containing the photograph, name and expiration date (for minors only)
- Vehicle registration with name and address (must match address on non-compliant driver's license)
- Utility bill showing the person's name and address of principal residence (must match address on non-compliant driver's license)
- Voter's registration card

## Real ID Act extension date explanation:

The extension date is a deadline when you must have one of the two new ID's (driver's license or state identification card). The “standard” driver's license, which is the one that DMV had previously issued will no longer be accepted in May 2025.

If you recently renewed or applied for a driver's license or state identification card you will receive one that is marked with a **STAR** emblem or marked with “**Federal Limits May Apply, Not for Federal Identification or Not for Federal Purposes**”.
