Army Emergency Relief

785-492-2972

Provides emergency financial assistance in times of distress, offering 0% interest loans and/or grants and scholarships.

Army Family Team Building (AFTB)

Provides training and knowledges to Soldiers and Family members to support the total Army effort.

Army Volunteer Corps (AVC)

Serves as the central point of contact for volunteer opportunities and recognition at Fort Riley.

Employment Readiness Program (ERP)

Provides employment assistance to Soldiers and Family members, including career counseling, job coaching, interview preparation, job search assistance and referral.

Ensures families with special needs have a core program that provides comprehensive and coordinated community support.

Family Advocacy Program (FAP)

Provides services that strengthen families' relationships by providing the tools to maintain safe and nurturing homes. Includes New Parent Support, EFMP, SHARP, and Victim Advocacy.

Financial Readiness Program (FRP)

Provides consumer and financial affairs assistance such as budget counseling, debt liquidation, and financial planning.
