

MEMORANDUM FOR SEE DISTRIBUTION

SUBJECT: Emergency Off-Limits Establishment Restriction – Veterans Motorcycle Clubhouse in Junction City, KS

1. In accordance with the emergency power established by AR 190-24, paragraph 2-6a, I hereby prohibit Service Members permanently or temporarily assigned to Fort Riley from patronizing the Veterans Motorcycle Clubhouse located at 1038 Grant Avenue, Junction City, KS 66441, pending action by the local Armed Forces Disciplinary Control Board. This prohibition is based upon conduct at that location which may adversely affect the health and well-being of military personnel or their Families, pursuant to AR 190-24, paragraph 2-4b(12).
2. Service Members assigned to Fort Riley are ordered not to enter or patronize the above mentioned location including any associated or adjacent property. Violations of this order are punishable under Article 92, Uniform Code of Military Justice.
3. Units will place this memorandum on their unit bulletin boards and give it the widest dissemination.
4. This memorandum supplements, but does not supersede, any previous 1st Infantry Division and Fort Riley policy letters or off-limits lists.
