BSEP provides courses addressing three specific Armed Forces Classification Testing (AFCT) subtests that comprise the GT score: Word Knowledge, Paragraph Comprehension, and Arithmetic Reasoning. Prerequisite: The Test of Adult Basic Education (TABE) and Command authorization/signature.

# BSEP CLASS RULES

- Attendance is **mandatory** and failure to attend class will result in unit contact and possible drop from class, unless due to an emergency, mission or illness.
- Class attire is duty uniform.
- Any course materials loaned to the Soldier must be returned to the instructor before the end date of class.
- Cell phones will be turned off or placed on vibrate while in the classroom.
- Refrain from smoking within 50 feet of the building. No chewing tobacco or vaping products in classroom or classroom buildings.
- The DA form 4187 is required to take the AFCT, Soldiers are **NOT obligated to take the exam.**
- All Soldiers will meet individually with the BSEP Coordinator or a counselor prior to the last day of class for feedback on the Qualifier/Predictor Test and recommendations for taking the AFCT.
- Soldiers who qualify to test (score at least 110 on Predictor Test) will be scheduled to take the AFCT retest in Bldg. 211, room 001B on the last scheduled day of class.
- Soldiers who do not obtain the recommended qualifying score to take re-take the AFCT are strongly encouraged to meet with a Counselor prior to re-testing.

## AFCT

- The AFCT may be administered as many times as needed during a Soldier's career.
- There is a 6 month waiting period between re-testing.
- The Military keeps the most recent AFCT score, not the highest score.
- The AFCT is comprised of 10 subtests.
- The GT score is made up of 3 subtests: Arithmetic Reasoning, Word Knowledge, and Paragraph Comprehension.
