Tobacco Awareness 2020



- National Tobacco 21 Law December 20, 2019, Raised the federal minimum age of sale of tobacco products from 18 to 21 years.
- AAFES and many off post retailers are no longer selling tobacco products to anyone under the age of 21.
- Projected full implementation is June 2020

•Ensure Soldiers with special needs Family members are assigned to installations that can provide the services needed.

•Synchronizes all available services in the support of special needs Families to enhance their Family quality of life.

•Provide information and referral on the resources available both in and outside the installation to fully integrate Families to community's capabilities.

•Individualized assistance is available through our EFMP System Navigator, who specializes in exploring options and services to effectively manage Family needs.

•Coordinate housing exceptions to policy for modifications such as air conditioners, fences and other, to support special needs conditions.

•Provide endorsement for compassionate reassignments, curtailments, extensions when special needs conditions warrant such requests.

•EFMP facilitates monthly support groups and recreational activities to engage Families in positive experiences.
