BSEP COURSES



The Basic Skills Education Program (BSEP) provides courses addressing three specific Armed Forces Classification Test (AFCT) subtests that comprise the GT score: Word Knowledge, Paragraph Comprehension, and Arithmetic Reasoning. BSEP courses are 3 weeks long, 3 hours per day.

Eligibility: Service Members and qualified dependents.

TA & CA: THE BASICS



Soldiers are allotted \$4,500 per fiscal year (FY) to use for Tuition Assistance (TA) and/or Credentialing Assistance (CA).

The FY is from 01 October to 30 September.

TA will fund 18 semester hours (SH) of college credit every FY at the rate of \$250 per SH. *Funds tuition only.

CA will fund courses, books/ materials, and exams that lead to industry recognized civilian credentials in an occupational area of your choice.
