Protect Yourself From Cryptocurrency Fraud

Cryptocurrency (or "crypto") is an electronic money system. When you buy crypto, you own a digital unit of a digital currency, not a share of a company. It's not issued or backed by a bank or government. You can buy or sell it, use as an investment or pay for things (where it's accepted). It's stored in a digital wallet (software or hardware device that holds your private key to your digital assets). Navy Federal doesn't offer crypto trading services.



What Could a Crypto Scam Look Like?

Fraudsters may impersonate people you'd trust like a financial advisor, bank or government official. They'll prey on your emotions and pressure you to act fast. Here are some common crypto scams.



Investment Scams

You're contacted by someone, claiming they've made millions investing in crypto, and that you can, too. They may pose as investment managers and set up imposter websites. Their goal is to keep you giving them money and prevent withdrawals.



Rug Pull Scams

Scammers hype up a new crypto coin or non-fungible token (NFT) that may not even exist to attract investors. Once they accumulate enough money, the scammers "pull the rug" out from under the victims by taking the funds and disappearing.



Romance Scams

Scammers reach out through dating apps or text messages. They'll build your trust through a long-distance romance. Then, they'll suggest you invest in a hot new "investment" or bail them out of a difficult situation using crypto.

Stop the Scam Before It Starts

1. Research and only use well-known, U.S.-based crypto exchanges with strong security measures to buy crypto.
2. Before purchasing a specific cryptocurrency, check if it has a white paper that explains its purpose, future plans and technology.
3. Verify anyone you're paying with crypto, because you can't reverse a crypto transaction.
4. Never share your seed phrase or accept seed phrases from others to transfer your cryptocurrency.
5. Don't deposit cash into Bitcoin ATMs.
6. Don't send money to someone you only know online.

2. Notify your bank.
3. Keep records of any communications.
4. File a report with the FBI Internet Crime Complaint center at [IC3.gov](https://ic3.gov). (If you're aged 60+ and need help filing the complaint, you can call the National Elder Fraud Hotline at 833-372-8311.)

Facts:

- **76 tornados occurred in Kansas during 2024** (Increase in tornadoes from the past year, 44 tornadoes in 2023). The 10-year average is 62 tornadoes per year.
- April was the most active month of the 2024 season for tornadoes with 40 reported (52.6%). The second largest outbreak occurred in May with 19 reported (25.0%).
- 2024 was a more active year for tornadoes in Kansas than recent years, with 76 tornadoes being reported in 39 different counties. The strongest tornado in 2024 occurred in Westmoreland, KS (Pottawatomie County) on April 30th. It was rated an EF-3 and unfortunately ended up killing one person and injuring 4 others. This tornado was on the ground for a little over 2 miles and produced intense damage.
- **Regional issues:**
 - Straight line damaging **winds**, large damaging **hail**, flash **flooding**, and **tornadoes** are the largest threats.
 - Personnel new to the region are at the greatest risk.
 - **Little to no notice on some severe weather events (<10 minutes)**

Assumptions:

- Severe Spring and Summer Weather season in 2025 will remain April to June for the highest risk, though storms can happen year-round.




