

Fort Riley Dial Plan

Revised 25 March 2020

Dialing instructions when calling from a 239 or 240 prefix

<u>Type of Call</u>	<u>Dial</u>
Emergency, Fire, Military Police	911
Government (Fort Riley)	239 or 240 + the 4-digit number DO NOT dial “785” in front of the prefix when dialing from another government phone
Local Area (Junction City, Wakefield Fort Riley/Non-Government, Milford)	99 + the 7-digit number. Junction City and Fort Riley prefixes: 209, 210, 223, 226, 238, 307, 375, 390, 492, 530, 579, 717, 761, 762, 784, 802, 684. Wakefield prefixes: 461, 707, 996. Milford prefixes: 463, 616.
Long Distance CONUS (A-1 and A-2 service)	97 + 1 + the 10-digit number
Long Distance OCONUS (A-1 service) Includes Alaska, Hawaii, Puerto Rico and Canada	97 + 1 + the 10-digit number
International (A-1 service only)	97 + 011 + the international number (May include country code, city code and local number)
DSN	94 + the 7 or 10-digit number
Toll Free	99 + 1 + the 10-digit number

The area code for the 239 and 240 prefix is 785.

The DSN prefixes for Fort Riley are 856 for 239 phone numbers and 520 for 240 phone numbers.

The area code for DSN numbers is 312 when calling to Fort Riley from OCONUS.

Dial 239-6789 to access voicemail. The default password is 1-2-3-4. To have the password reset, have your TCO or IMO create an ITSM work order.
