

Access to services and programs conducted or funded by the government

Sections 502(Access Board under the Architectural Barriers Act (ABA)), 504(programs, services, and facilities) and 508 (digital content) of the Rehabilitation Act applies to individuals who are not directly employed by DA to include:

1. Family members of employees
2. Family members of Service members
3. Veterans
4. Students
5. Patients at medical treatment facilities
6. The general public
7. Non-affiliated staff

Accessibility of buildings is for those that are open to and service the public. Investigations into allegations of discrimination under section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, as amended and all applicable laws and regulations are to be processed in accordance with Department of Defense (DoD) Directive 1020.1.

Responsibility for investigation will be completed by the appropriate installation.
