THE ADMISSIONS PROCESS

- Service members that meet disability requirements and/or have achieved veteran status, regardless of age and income are provided priority enrollment. **(FLINT HILLS JOB CORPS HAS BEEN GIVEN PERMISSION BY THE NATIONAL OFFICE TO ENROLL MILITARY MEMBER DURING HIS OR HER SIX MONTH PERIOD OF TRANSITIONING FROM HIS OR HER END OF ACTIVE DUTY SERVICE DATE.)**
- Military spouses are provided income eligibility waivers and priority enrollment.
- Family members age 16 – 24, that meet eligibility requirements are provided priority enrollment.
- A completed application, appropriate identification, eligibility documentation, and a formal interview are required.
- Visit us for a center tour on the first and third Thursday each month. Tours begin at 2:00 pm.
