Current Foot Print: : Classroom for 24 Students/4 Instructors

- WARTAC is a Career Skills Program sponsored by the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA), Veterans Benefits Administration, in partnership with Fort Riley, to train transitioning Soldiers in VA Compensation Claims processing.
- This 10-week program provides participants with an opportunity to learn the skillset of a VA Veteran Service Representative (VSR) that work in VA Veteran Service Centers across the country and serve Veterans concerning VA compensation or pension claims.
- Starting salary range for GS-7 is \$34K annually with pay differentials based on location. After first year, promotes to GS-9 and after second year, promotes to GS-10

What are the eligibility requirements?

- Be on Active Duty and be within 180 days of Separation as of the Class Start Date
- Anticipate a fully Honorable or Under Honorable Conditions Character of Service
- Meet OPM Hiring Guidelines for GS-0996-07/10
- BN Commander's Support for Attendance
