

The Trusted Traveler program allows valid DoDID card holders to enter Fort Novosel without the requirement for occupants of the same vehicle to present identification. The Trusted Traveler program does not apply to restricted areas, airfields, or heliports.

## Effective 1 October 2023

- Trusted Travelers are U.S. service members, adult dependents, DoD employees, and military retirees and their spouses with valid DoD identification.
- Trusted Travelers are <u>not</u> installation visitor pass holders, volunteers, family care providers, foreign personnel, contractors, tow truck drivers, or taxi, limousine, shuttle, or ride-share drivers conducting duties for commercial purposes (even with valid DoD identification).
- Trusted Travelers are limited to a single non-commercial vehicle and may not vouch for personnel in another vehicle.
- Trusted Travelers with valid DOD identification will always be verified and may only vouch for occupants in the same vehicle.
- Trusted Travelers must remain with personnel they are escorting who are not in possession of a valid DOD ID, or authorized Fort Novosel visitor credential, and they must ensure all vehicle occupants have a valid form of identification in their possession.

• Trusted Traveler hours are from 5 a.m. to 10 p.m. (0500-2200), 7 days a week.
