



How to Open Additional Exchange Mailboxes in Outlook


1. Click “File,” “Account Settings,” then “Account Settings” again.
2. Double click **Your E-mail address**.




3. Click **More Settings**.




4. Click the **Advanced** tab.




5. Under **Mailboxes**, click **Add**
