SUBJECT: Divestiture of Organizational Clothing and Individual Equipment

1. References Army Regulation 710-2, (Inventory Management, Supply Policy) below the National Level, 28 March 2008.
2. Over the past ten years of conflict, with constant product improvements and regular fielding's for deployment, the Army has accumulated surplus Organizational Clothing and Individual Equipment (OCIE) items.
3. In order to reduce cost and improve inventory management, Army Materiel Command is authorized to divest OCIE stocks that are in excess of four years of supply; with the exception of Improved Outer Tactical Vests, Ballistic Plates, and Army Combat Helmets.
4. The first choice for divestiture of surplus OCIE stocks is, in order, to the U.S. Army Reserves, National Guard, and Cadet Command.
5. Surplus OCIE, other than limitations in three and redistributed in four above, will be turned into the nearest Defense Logistics Agency Disposition Services.
6. In Outside the Continental United States locations, only OCIE with less than one year of supply will be retrograded to Continental United States, with the exception of Improved Outer Tactical Vests, Ballistic Plates, and Army Combat Helmets.
