MEMORANDUM FOR U.S. Army Garrison Directorates and Tenant Organizations

SUBJECT: U.S. Army Garrison Fort Stewart and Hunter Army Airfield, Policy #26, Recognize Excellence in the Command Supply Discipline Program

1. References.

2. The CSDP is a Commander's program designed to assist subordinate directors, primary hand receipt holders and supervisors in carrying out supply system responsibilities throughout the command. The CSDP establishes command, supervisory, and managerial responsibilities necessary to comply with regulatory requirements and to verify AFSBn-Stewart activities are adhering to Army supply accountability standards. This Command policy will incentivize excellence within the Organization. The purpose of the AFSBn-Stewart Policy is to ensure compliance with Department of the Army supply policy and procedures in recognizing organizational superior performance in supply discipline. Commanders should use the results from the Command Supply Discipline Checklist as the tool in superior performance.

3. Examples for a rating of Commendable:

- a. DA Civilians: Time off Award, "On the Spot" award, Civilian Service Achievement Medal, or Commanders Coin.
- b. Military: Certificate of Achievement, Four Day Pass, Army Achievement Medal, or Commanders Coin.
