

Non-Standard Training Request

All non-standard training requires the submission of a Range Concept of Operation (CONOP). A non-standard training event is any training that exceeds the standard capabilities of the facility or falls outside of safety regulations. In addition to non-standard training, CONOPs are required for all Red Cloud Ranges, live-fire exercises, shoothouses, Engineer Qualification Area (EQA), Waterborne Operations within the FSGA/HAAF training complex, and Convoy Live Fire Area.

Concept of Operation Requirements (Submit NLT 42 days prior to training):

- (1) Non-Standard Training Request (NSTR) Form, signed by the Commander.
- (2) Graphics, in color, depicting the scheme of maneuver (SOM). Graphics should include, at a minimum: grid coordinates for firing positions, target positions, and maneuver boxes; and azimuths for sectors of fire.
- (3) ROZ Request for SUAS Operations above 75 feet AGL.
- (4) DD Form 2977, Deliberate Risk Assessment Worksheet signed by the appropriate level Commander for the residual risk.
- (5) Shot Sheets, required for Red Cloud Range Complex facilities.
- (6) RFMSS summary, with dates corresponding to the training dates.
- (7) Target Request Form, if drawing targets from Range Control Target Warehouse.
