

Training Support



Ranges

- 279,206 acres of Training Land and Ranges.
- 104 live fire facilities; 23 small arms ranges, 7 gunnery ranges, 52 indirect firing points, 3 shoothouses, 7 UOSs, 11 special use facilities.
- 575 miles of paved roads, 313 miles of dirt roads, 537 miles of tank trails—the distance from Ft. Stewart to Denver, Colorado.



Colmar Urban Training Facility

- 26 Training Buildings of which 24 are Instrumented.
- Single level and multi-story buildings with breach able doors.
- Replication of residential housing and commercial businesses
- Furnishings and props to add to realism.



Virtual Training Facility

The Virtual Training Facility (VTF) centralized all Engagement Skill Trainer (EST) devices located on Ft. Stewart.


- Provides a three day (24 hour) Instructor/Operator (I/O) Course.
- Drive-in capability to support Wheeled Vehicles up to MRAP.
- 70 Firing Lanes
- Heavy Weapons Suite
- Three Operational Modes – Marksmanship, Unit Collective Squad level and Shoot/Don't Shoot
- Similar capabilities at Hunter Army Airfield EST facility.



Virtual Battle Space 3

A semi-immersive, shared first-person shooter training environment suitable for squads, platoons & companies to maneuver and practice:

- Troop Leading Procedures (TLPs)
- Tactical operations & decision making
- Mounted & dismounted operations
- Reaction to IEDs, snipers, ambushes, etc.
- Everything that happens in VBS3 is recorded and available for AARs
- Multiple weapons/vehicle platforms
- Integrates Fire Support, CAS & Aviation
