This is protective service work at the trainee level in the enforcement of laws and ordinances for the protection of life and property. Contacts require skills in understanding human behavior and

those factors which influence or cause behavioral changes and are critical in adversarial and confrontational situations. Work follows standard operating procedures.

Contacts with others require skills in understanding human behavior and those factors which influence or cause behavioral changes, are critical to job success, and involves significant interaction with people at all levels within or outside the department.
