





Gate 1 Active Vehicle Barrier Construction Traffic

- Estimated Completion is in the first half of March
- Gate 2 will close upon completion of the project

In-Lane Vetting, Visitor Passes, and Ride Shares

- In-Lane Vetting is active at all gates except 4C (2 ABCT Alternate)
- Rideshare and gig delivery drivers (DoorDash, etc) can use in-lane vetting
- Common Issues: Weapons, Drugs, Convictions, Expired DL/Reg/Insurance

Speeding & Traffic Safety

- Over 250 speeding tickets issued in January
- 3ID Speeding Policy issues suspensions of installation driving privileges for 20+ MPH over the limit
 - 1st Offense: 30-day suspension
 - 2nd Offense: 6-month suspension
 - 3rd Offense: 1 year suspension
- GA Super Speeder Law: \$200 fine on top of speeding fine (\$15/MPH over)
 - 75+ MPH on 2-lane roads
 - 85+ MPH on multi-lane roads
- 2 ABCT is in the field until the end of Feb, expect delays at crossing points
