## ADDITIONAL GUIDANCE

- The Fort Stewart NCO Academy is Located 18 miles North of Ft. Stewart Main Post, and 6 miles South of Pembroke, GA.
- The posted Speed Limit along GA HWY 119 is 55 MPH.
- When you turn onto Academy Rd., the posted speed limit is 35 MPH until it drops to 20 MPH.
- While passing troops the speed limit is always 10 MPH.
