

Government Shutdown Impacted Resources

As of Oct. 31, 2025



FINANCIAL CONCERNS

- ❑ If you are facing missed payments due to the shutdown, contact your Security Officer for more information on assistance with impact to your security clearance
- ❑ **Defense Travel System** voucher pay out for travel expenses is paused. Citi Bank will not age any balances, and no payments are due from Government Travel Cardholders until the shutdown is over.
- ❑ **Army Military Pay Office** is unable to process advances or casual pay until appropriations are approved. Death gratuities are forwarded to Ft. Leavenworth for payment

MOVEMENTS

- ❑ ETS and separations will be extended by 45 days effective Oct. 22.
- ❑ Retirements will be extended to Nov. 30.
- ❑ FY 2025 funded Permanent Change of Station orders continue if they require non-temporary household goods storage.

ARMY COMMUNITY SERVICE

- ❑ **Army Substance Abuse Programs** are paused.
- ❑ **Suicide Prevention, Risk Reduction, and Employee Assistance Program Support** is paused.
- ❑ The **Victim Advocacy Program** has been paused.

SOLDIER/FAMILY SERVICES

- ❑ **DEERS Family ID Card** services are paused.
- ❑ **Fort Stewart Education Center** services are **degraded**, and classroom availability is paused.
- ❑ **IDES:** VA legal rating review is only being conducted for extreme cases; delaying all others.
- ❑ **Occupational Healthcare** Medical Professionals are not available to complete part 2 of the required annual physical for Emergency Essential Employees.
