- ✓ Performs a comprehensive assessment of referred adolescents and families.
- ✓ Performs individual, and/or group counseling, and/or family counseling as necessary.

REQUIREMENTS

- ✓ Master's degree from an accredited university.
- ✓ Drug and Alcohol Certification.
- ✓ Licensed as an independent level provider Licensed Clinical Social Worker (LCSW) or Clinical/Counseling Psychologist at PhD level, (Other Master's/licensure as LPC, LMHC, LCMHC or LMFT as approved by COR following transcript review).
- ✓ Two (2) years of supervised post graduate counseling experience working with an adolescent population.
- ✓ Must be able to operate general office equipment including but not limited to: computer, phones and related media and information devices on most or all workdays.
- ✓ Ability to communicate and interact with others, both in person and/or by telephone to conduct business.
- ✓ Ability to work under time pressure. and rapidly for long periods to meet deadlines.

- Must be a US citizen.
- Must be able to obtain a favorably adjudicated Tier 1 clearance

CERTIFICATION PATHWAYS

- MYCAA offers qualifying military spouses financial assistance toward educational programs. Among these programs are AFC and CFP qualifying pathways.
- AFC: requires a high school diploma and 1000 hours of financial coaching taking approximately 6-12 months to reach certification.
- CFP: requires a 4-year degree, with multiple pathways to reach certification
