Child Supervisory Policy



- Children **Newborn - 8 y/o** will have close supervision at all times.
- Children **9-12 y/o** may be left unattended in quarters for a max of **2 hours** during the day.
- Children **13 y/o** may be left unattended in quarters for a max of **3 hours** during the day.
- Children **14 y/o** may be left unattended for a max of **6 hours**.
- Children **15-17 y/o** of age may be left unattended in quarters for a max of **8 hours**.
- Children **9-17 y/o** must be provided a telephone number where the parent(s)/guardian(s) can be reached as well as telephone numbers for the police and fire department and the hospital.

GUIDELINES FOR BABYSITTING

- Children **13 years & older** may care for younger children if they've attended Babysitting Class for teens.
- Children **13-14 years** may care for younger siblings for a maximum of **3 hours** without direct supervision.
- Children **15-17 years** may care for younger siblings for a maximum **8 hours**, without direct supervision.
This does not include overnight care.
- Children will not be supervised by anyone **under 18 years of age** for more than **8 hours** overnight.



Curfew For Children Under 18



- Children **11 years old or younger** shall be inside their home or someone else's home between 2100-0600.
- Children **12 years old**, but less than 15 years old, shall be inside their home or someone else's home between 2200-0600.
- Children who, are **15 years old, but less than 18 years old**, shall be inside their home or someone else's home between midnight and 0600.
- **Children 11 years old and under** will not be left unattended for any period in a vehicle.

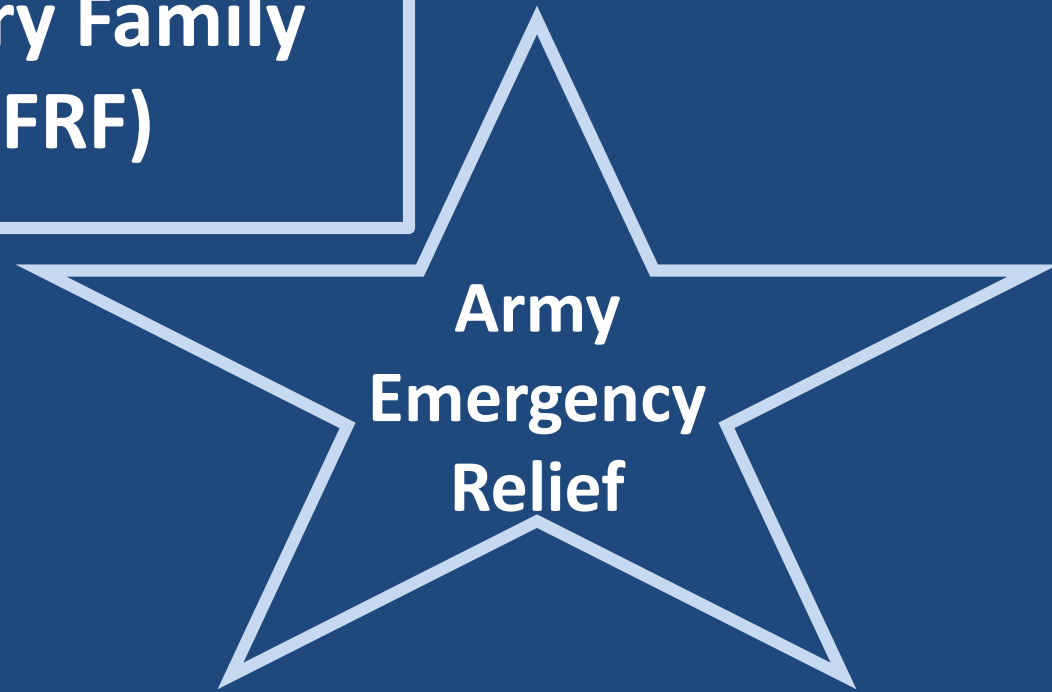

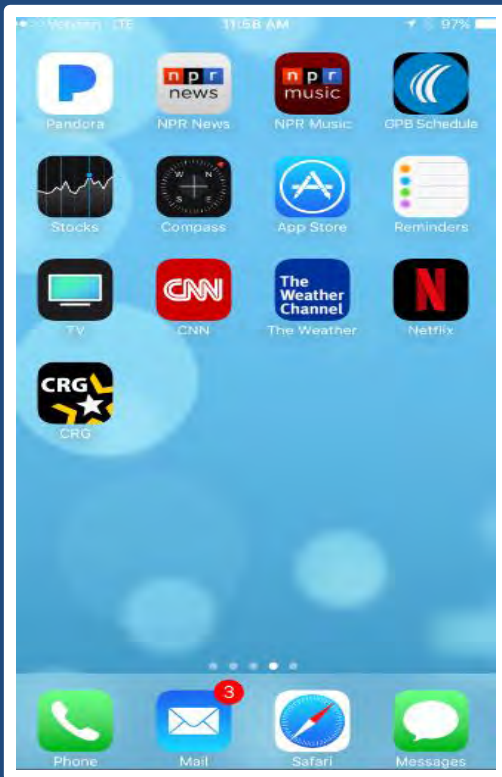
Army Emergency Relief Smart Phone App

Community Resource Guide Phone App



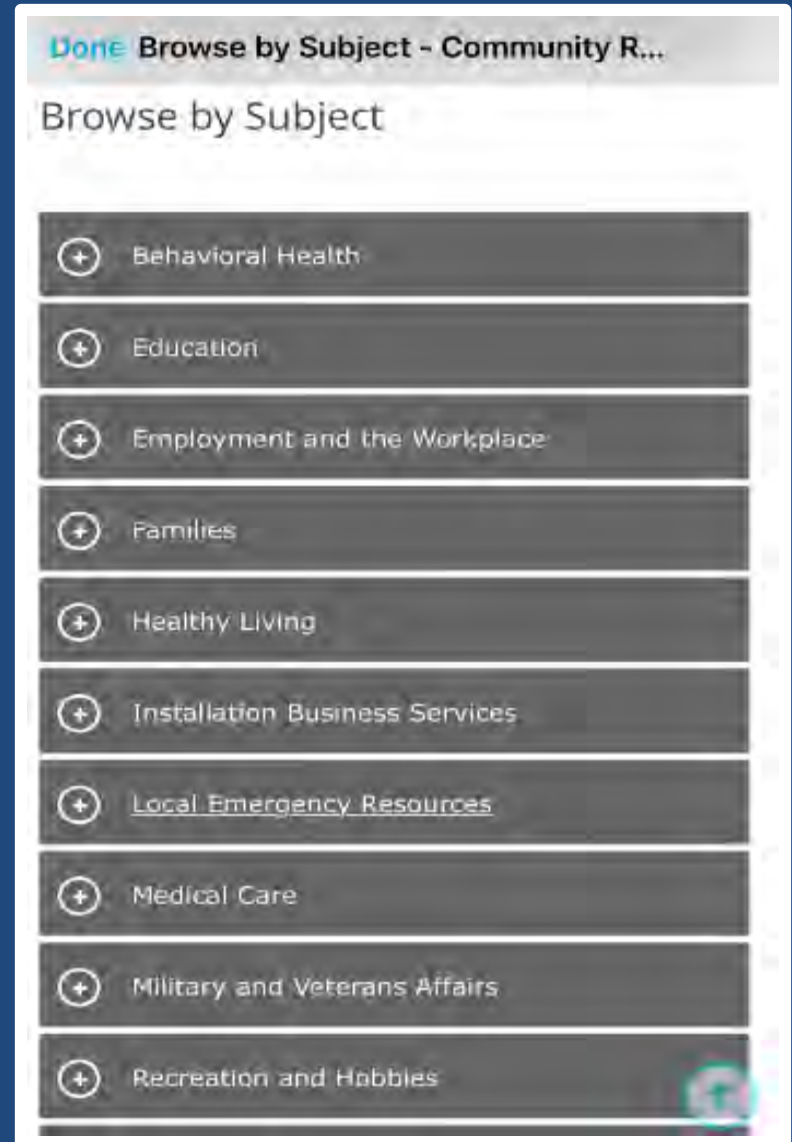
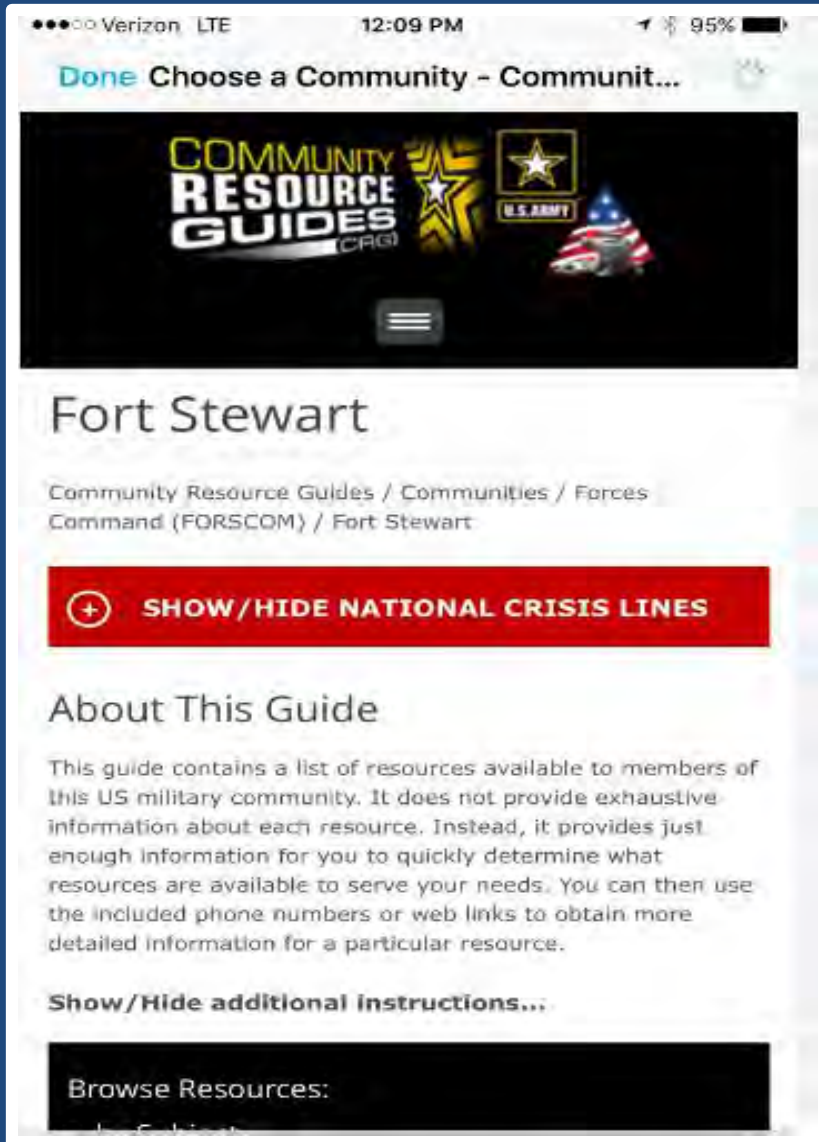
The CRG app is available for free for androids and i-phones. Search for “community resource guide” in the app store and it will be the second option that appears.
