





Army Community Service

Emergency Family Assistance Center (EFAC)

- ➤ The EFAC is a facility that, when activated by the Garrison Commander, will help Soldiers and Families recover after Natural Disasters, Emergencies, or other Crisis situations
- ➤ The EFAC is staffed with ACS personnel and Garrison representatives and will serve as a "One Stop" shop for Soldiers and Families to get updated information, assistance, and access to essential programs and services
 - Can be augmented with civilian agencies such as the American Red Cross and the USO
- ➤ The EFAC is scalable and adjustable in order to effectively meet the needs of the Ft. Stewart and HAAF military communities

CONUS EVACUATIONS

REIMBURSEMENTS

- If you live in a mandatory evacuation zone and the Senior Commander ordered an evacuation you will be reimbursed by the Army for mileage, per diem and lodging (if you stayed in a commercial hotel.)
- Family members 12 years and older get full per diem based on the per diem rate of your safe haven. Children under 12 get ½ per diem rate.
- 3. If you live off post and the Senior Commander did not order an evacuation you can seek reimbursement through FEMA.
- 4. When you get back the Soldiers will file vouchers in DTS and Family Members will file vouchers at your Brigade's Hurricane Voucher Center.
- Garrison will support all the non-divisional unit family members with filing evacuation vouchers. (Processed 1292 for Hurricane Irma)





CONUS EVACUATIONS

LESSONS LEARNED

- 1. Keep your lodging receipts. You can only be reimbursed for lodging from receipts that are in your name.
- 2. No need to keep gas or food receipts.
- 3. You will not be reimbursed for pet expenses.
- 4. Only Family Members listed in DEERS will be reimbursed for per diem.
- 5. If you drive 2 cars, you can claim 2 cars.
- 6. DFAS Rome, NY pays the voucher settlements and they will send experts here to assist us at the beginning of the voucher process.
- If you have damage to your house hold goods or food in refrigerator, please notify your insurance company.

IPPS-A is Coming!!

- ✓ IPPS-A will be fielded in mid-September
- ✓ Prior to and during fielding, there will be a BOCO with no routine personnel updates in a live Personnel data system
- ✓ During BOCO, daily accountability will be accomplished through manual spreadsheets
- ✓ Arrivals/Departures will be executed by the MPD manually through an AMC sharepoint portal unit coordination for critical to ensure fidelity/accuracy
- ✓ Soldiers with a Report Date (RD) during the BOCO window may request to have their RD amended to either before or after the window by HRC
 - ✓ This is NOT A STOP MOVE. It is an HRC process to limit PCS accountability issues during the transition to IPPS-A
 - ✓ MPD Continues to await Soldier Packets to produce PCS orders

- ✓ If you put in a 30-Day Notice before your lease expires without orders or if a Waterfall resident, there is a lease termination fee that is equivalent to one month of rent
- ✓A pre inspection is scheduled along with a move out date. The resident needs to be present for both scheduled inspections.
- ✓BAH is paid one month behind: ex., July 1 pays for June rent.
- ✓ Active Duty will get refunded 3 to 5 business days after the 1st of the month once allotment is received




