#### TIMELINE



- 0600: Formation (All Students) Schools NCO's and Sponsors standing by in front of BLC Barracks buildings.
- 0645: NLT all students assigned to a PLT and in the classroom
- **0700 0800**: Grab n' Go Breakfast
- 0800: Height / Weight Screening begins
- 0900 UTC: Administrative in-processing, Ht/Wt, and packing list layouts



## Directions





The Ft. Stewart NCO Academy is located 18 mi, 24 minutes North of Main Post. 6 miles, 11 minutes South of Pembroke, Ga.

The posted speed limit along 119 is 55 mph.

When you turn off of 119 onto Academy Road, the posted speed limit is 35 mph. As you approach the Academy, it drops to 20 mph.

Anyone driving on Academy Road will slow to 10 mph if passing troops.

Students will park their vehicles in the student parking lot.

All students will be formed up NLT 0600 in the formation area in front of the pull-up bars as depicted to the left.

Students will report to formation in Army Combat Uniform ("OCPs") with the following items:

- -Student Packet (Hard Copy)
- -Military ID (CAC)
- -Pen & Paper

SCHOOLS NCOs & SPONSORS – Park in the open area designated on this slide. Sponsors will wait under the pavilion indicated by the red block.

Students will park in the student parking lot, then proceed to formation.

In-processing will begin promptly at 0600.

Students will report to formation in the Army Combat Uniform ("OCPs") with the following items:

- -Military ID (CAC)

Schools NCOs & Sponsors will remain in vicinity in front of the Barracks buildings as indicated on the map. DO NOT approach the student formation.
