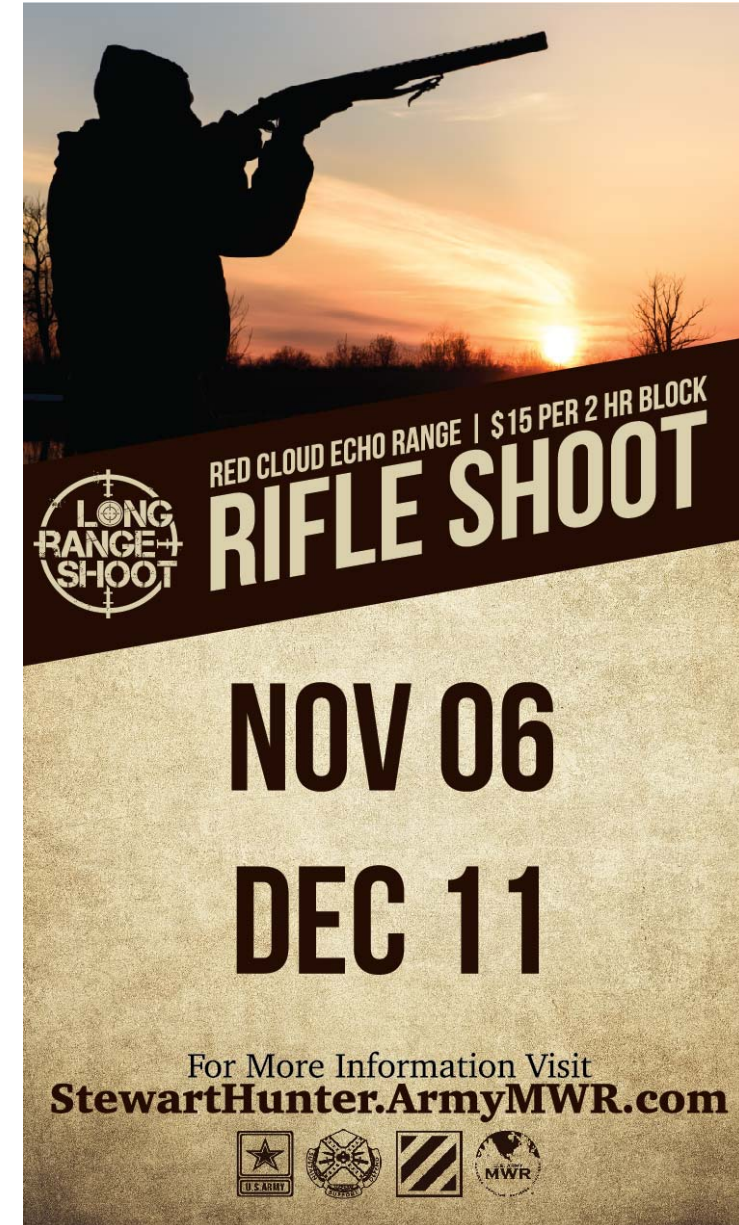

Home Based Business

Step 1: Download HBB application from MWR website.

Step 2: Complete the Application.

This includes visiting and obtaining approval from installation agencies like the housing office and community housing manager. The application should identify the agencies, but ask your MWR representative if you have questions. If you need any additional documentation (like licensing or certifications), get that, too.

*Please note that Liberty & Chatham Counties do not issue business licenses to on-post residents.

Step 3: Turn in the Application:

Once you've completed your paperwork, submit the application to your Garrison DFMWR. Keep a copy of the completed application for your own records.

DEERS ID CARDS

In response to COVID-19, OSD authorized automatic extensions in DEERS for below ID card categories that expired between January 1, 2020 and July 31, 2021

- August 31, 2021 for all Foreign Affiliates and their dependents
- October 31, 2021 for dependents of Active Duty, Reserve and National Guard
- January 31, 2022 for Retirees and their dependents, and all other populations

Cards can be renewed up to 30 days prior to expiration -don't wait for the actual expiration date!

CHANGES:

- Remote USID card renewals and reissuance opportunities
- Minimum age level for initial USID card issuance is 14 yrs. of age

COMMAND POLICY LETTER NO. 5
Speeding and Installation Driving Privileges

1. References.

- 32 Code of Federal Regulations, Subpart B (Driving Privileges), 12 April 2005.
- Army Regulation (AR) 190-5 (Motor Vehicle Traffic Supervision), 22 May 2006.
- AR 600-20 (Army Command Policy), 24 July 2020.

2. Scope. This policy applies to all individuals introducing and operating motor vehicles on the installations of Fort Stewart, Georgia (FSGA) and Hunter Army Airfield, Georgia (HAAF).

3. Purpose. This policy establishes guidelines to maintain and improve safety and good order and discipline on FSGA and HAAF installations and to ensure the safe and efficient movement of vehicles and personnel on FSGA and HAAF.

4. Policy.

- Delegation. I am designating the Garrison Commanders of FSGA and HAAF the authority to implement programs, consistent with AR 190-5 and this policy letter, for installation driving privilege matters, to include the suspension and revocation of installation driving privileges on each of their respective installations.
- Speeding. All persons introducing and operating motor vehicles on FSGA or HAAF will do so in accordance with posted speed limits. All persons operating a motor vehicle on these installations traveling at a rate of speed 20 miles per hour or greater above the posted speed limit on FSGA or HAAF will have their installation driving privileges suspended for a minimum of 30 calendar days. Consistent with AR 190-5, paragraph 24.b., this suspension will become effective 14 calendar days after the individual is notified of their right to an administrative hearing before a designated hearing officer. If the individual elects to appear for an administrative hearing, the suspension will be deferred pending the outcome of the hearing. If the individual requests a continuance of the administrative hearing date beyond the 14-day period, the suspension will become effective immediately on receipt of notice that the request for

continuance has been granted, and remain in force pending a hearing at a scheduled hearing date.

c. Repeat Incidents of Speeding. Individuals cited a second time by law enforcement within a year for traveling 20 miles per hour or greater above the posted speed limit on FSGA or HAAF will have their on-post driving privileges suspended for 12 months in a manner consistent with AR 190-5.

d. Alleged Speeding by Military Personnel. DD Form 1408 (Armed Forces Traffic Ticket) will be issued to all military personnel cited for operating a motor vehicle over the posted speed limit. The DD Form 1408 will be directed to the military personnel's Special Court-Martial Convening Authority for disposition. The Special Court-Martial Convening Authority will promptly notify the FSGA/HAAF Magistrate Court, through their supporting Judge Advocate, the disposition of their citation/DD Form 1408 for operating a motor vehicle over the posted speed limit to ensure any potential further disposition of speeding is in accordance with law and regulation.

5. This policy is effective immediately and remains in effect until suspended, revoked, or superseded. Nothing in this policy is intended to contradict or eliminate any of the responsibilities and requirements enumerated in the above references.

- **Military Personnel** will be issued a **DD Form 1408** for speed infractions vs a CVB directed to BDE CDR for disposition.
- **Civilians and Family Members** will be issued **CVBs**

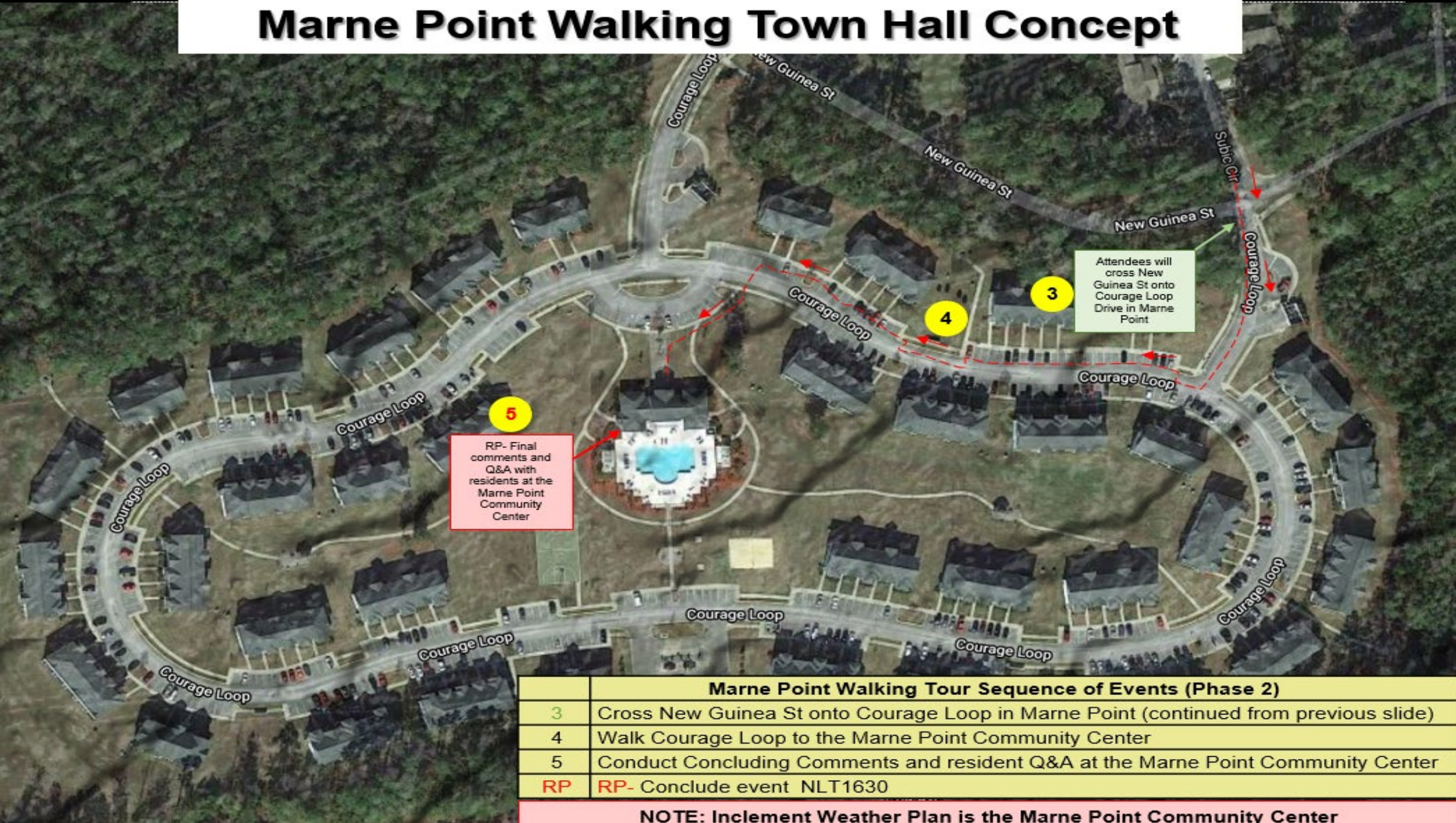

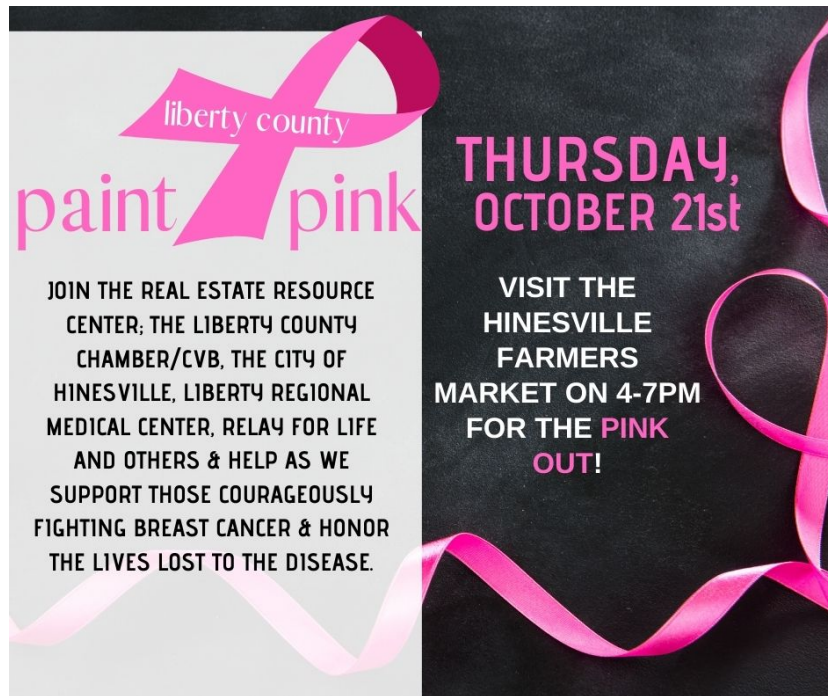
