MEMORANDUM FOR Soldiers, DoD Civilians, and Family Members of Fort Stewart and Hunter Army Airfield

SUBJECT: Termination of Evacuation Order (Hurricane Dorian)

1. On 2 September 2019, under the authority of the Joint Travel Regulation (JTR), I issued an evacuation order to all Soldiers, DoD Civilians, and Family Members whose residential quarters are located in an area identified for mandatory evacuation by civilian authorities, and within 200 miles of their sponsor's assigned duty location

2. I am terminating the evacuation order effective **1000, 6 SEP 19**.

a. Critical workforce personnel will return as directed by their Chain of Command or Staff Director.

b. Evacuees whose safe haven is 400 miles or less from their primary duty station. Lodging is authorized at the safe haven location the night of 5 SEP 19. These evacuees should begin travel no later than 6 SEP 19, and have **one travel day** (6 SEP 19) to complete return travel to the local area.

c. Evacuees whose safe haven is 401 miles or more from their primary duty station. Lodging is authorized at the safe haven location the night of 5 SEP 19. These evacuees should begin travel no later than 6 SEP 19, and have **two travel days** (6-7 SEP 19) to complete travel to the local area.

3. Evacuees should proceed by the safest route possible. Due to the local and regional impact of Hurricane Dorian, if road or weather conditions pose an unreasonable safety risk for return within the allotted time, individual evacuees may seek approval for a 24 hour delay in termination of the evacuation order. I delegate to Commanders in the rank of O-6 or above to grant one 24-hour delay in termination of the evacuation order based on safety conditions.

4. Commanders and Staff Directors will ensure evacuees submit travel vouchers no later than **30 SEP 2019** in accordance with the instructions that will be published by GB/Resource Management Office in order to accomplish timely payment of travel entitlements. Extensions to this deadline may be granted by Commanders in the grade of O-6.


5. Soldiers must inform their Chain of Command and/or supervisors if residences are uninhabitable due to storm damage. Units and organizations/activities will provide a

consolidated report of residences identified as uninhabitable no later than 1500, 10 SEP 2019.
