

Visitor Pass Restriction Update

Effective 5 am 20 May 2020, many of the visitor restrictions that were in place due to COVID 19 will be relaxed or lifted.

Patrons with valid visitor passes, to include passes issued for the purpose of visitation and recreation, will be re-instated and will scan for entry at installation access points.

Taxi and Ride Share drivers with valid visitor passes will be re-instated and will scan for entry at installation access points.

Taxi and Ride Share drivers without passes are encouraged go to the visitor control center to request a pass for up to 60 days. All fares riding within a Taxi or Ride Share on post will be required to have a valid DOD ID card or AIE pass to enter the installation.

The Trusted Traveler program remains suspended; all patrons entering the gate must have a valid installation pass or DOD identification card (Common Access Card, Dependent, Retiree, etc.)

Pass renewals, and applications for new passes will be granted with the following control measures:

- . Patrons will be required to go to the Visitor Control Center in person.

- . Patrons requesting a visitor pass will be required to present a memorandum signed by the Service Members Commander, stating the name of the person requiring the pass, the purpose of the pass, and the duration of the pass OR a memorandum from a supporting Garrison agency signed by the Director to justify the request.

Captain Commanders can sign a visitor request for installation pass for up to 7 days

Lieutenant Colonel Commanders can sign an visitor request for installation pass for up to 90 days

Colonel Commanders can sign an visitor request for installation pass for up to 365 days

Patrons who access the installation with a Veteran's Health Identification Card and Gold Star Family members will not require a memorandum for renewal.

Visitor Control Centers are located at Gate 1 (Fort Stewart) and Montgomery Gate (Hunter Army Airfield). Their hours of operation are 5am to 7pm, 7 days a week.
