DPTMS - 2023 Atlantic Hurricane Season

Hurricane Preparedness

- Hurricanes are among nature's most powerful and destructive weather items. On average, 12 tropical storms, 6 of which become hurricanes form over the Atlantic Ocean, Caribbean Sea, or Gulf of Mexico during the hurricane season which runs from June 1 to November 30 each year. <u>September</u> is historically the most active part of the year for FS/HAAF.
- **5** out of the last **8** years, severe weather and several hurricanes impacted both FS/HAAF operations.
- Close coordination will take place between 3ID Division Operations Center (DOC) and the Installation Emergency Operations Center (IEOC) to monitor any threatening weather event to ensure the SC has the most current data to prepare for and evacuate if necessary.











DPTMS - 2023 Atlantic Hurricane Season

 Please monitor the FS/HAAF Social Media platforms (Facebook, Twitter, Garrison App) as they become the primary messaging platform in case of evacuation. Families must be prepared to evacuate without their Soldier sponsor due to mission requirements.

Hard Lessons Learned for evacuation

- · Keep lodging receipts if evacuated.
- No need to keep gas or food receipts
- No reimbursement for pet expenses
- Only Family Member listed in DEERS will be reimbursed.
- If you drive 2 cars, you can claim 2 cars.
- If you have damage to your household, or food in the refrigerator, please notify your insurance company.

 - Including tables and chairs for all supporting agencies



DHR – IPPS-A Update

IPPS-A is Here And Improving Every Day!!

- ✓ IPPS-A went live in December 2022 and Personnel operations continue to incrementally improve across the board
- ✓ HQs driven work-arounds have mitigated most operations that were not fully functional such as transition/retirement orders and DD Forms 214
 - ✓ Our Transition backlog has dropped to near zero and we no longer have DD Forms 214 issues
- ✓ Local focus has shifted to Component transfers and assignments
- ✓ Component transfers impact Soldiers returning to the AC from the USAR or ARNG and require a significant amount of effort to resolve due to issues with losing components and MEPS interface
- ✓ Assignments are managed in two buckets, legacy and IPPS-A, based on report date
 - ✓ In general, assignments with report dates prior to 1 July are generated by the MPD through the legacy process
 - √ Assignments with report dates 1 July or later will generated in IPPS-A
 - ✓ HRC provides CONUS orders and the MPD provides OCONUS orders
- ✓ Close collaboration with 3ID and the MPD continues to be exceptional in resolving issues as they arise
