

Dear Ms Rutland:

The Georgia Environmental Protection Division (EPD) has reviewed the September 2013 Final Corrective Action Plan Progress Report (#9) submitted by ARCADIS for the site referenced above.

EPD approves of the request for no further action for the release #3 at the former AST 7001&7003 site. However, further corrective action may be required, if mandated through more stringent state or federal statutory or regulatory changes. Additional measures may also be required if existing or future drinking water systems or surface water bodies within two miles of the site are impacted by any dissolved contamination resulting from this release, or if previously unidentified soil contamination, dissolved contamination or free product are identified as originating at the site.
