
Dear Lieutenant Colonel Brown:

We have received your February 26, 1998 letter regarding the voluntarily submitted Compliance Status Report for the above referenced site. Since corrective action for the site is required by Consent Order No. EPD-HW-1068, it is a Class IV site pursuant to Rule 391-3-19-.06(2)(c) of the Rules for Hazardous Site Response and is presumed to be in compliance with the Type 5 risk reduction standards established in Rule 391-3-19-.07(10). The requirements of Rules 391-3-19-.06(3) through (5) [which address compliance status reports, certification of compliance with risk reduction standards and determination of the need for corrective action] do not apply to this site unless:

- You elect to certify compliance with other than Type 5 risk reduction standards of Rule 391-3-19-.07, in which case the site shall remain on the Hazardous Site Inventory as Class IV until the Director reclassifies it in accordance with Rule 391-3-19-.06;
- The Director determines that the corrective action required by Consent Order No. EPD-HW-1068 fails to protect human health and the environment and that additional corrective action is necessary to comply with the risk reduction standards of Rule 391-3-19-.07, in which case the Director may reclassify the site in accordance with 391-3-19-.06(6)(f); or
- The Director determines that corrective action required by Consent Order No. EPD-HW-1068 fails to meet the Type 5 risk reduction standards of Rule 391-3-19-.07(10), in which case the Director may reclassify the site pursuant to 391-3-19-.06(6)(f).

Oversight for the corrective action conducted at the site will be provided by the program handling enforcement of the Order, the Facilities Compliance Program of the Hazardous Waste Management Branch. As you may know, that program's compliance officer for your site is Brent Rabon. The Hazardous Sites Response Program will not be providing any further overview of reports, plans or other documents associated with any corrective action required by Consent Order No. EPD-HW-1068 unless the bulleted conditions above apply.
