The Georgia Environmental Protection Division (EPD) has completed its review of the Revised Final Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) Facility Investigation (RFI) Report dated September 1999, the Corrective Action Completion Report dated October 2005, the Letter Report for the Surface Soil Sampling at the PDO Yard dated March 2008, and the Draft Letter Report for the Surface Soil Sampling at the PDO Yard dated May 6, 2008 for the above referenced site. Based on our review of the above documents, EPD has determined the site meets residential risk reduction standards for soil and groundwater. In accordance with Rule 391-3-19-.06(6)(1) of the Rules for Hazardous Site Response (Rules), EPD is designating this site as not needing further corrective action.

Therefore, in accordance with Rule 391-3-19-.05(4)(b) of the Rules, the Hunter Army Airfield – PDO Yard site is now delisted from the Hazardous Site Inventory. As required by Rule 391-3-19-.06(5)(f) of the Rules, a notice announcing this determination shall be published in the *Savannah Morning News* and *Savannah City Guide*.
