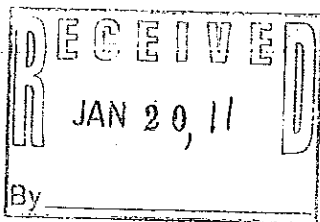

Thank you for submitting the Final Site Investigation Report for HAAF-18 Boundary Investigation, Hunter Army Airfield (HAAF) dated July 8, 2010 and received August 03, 2010 by the Land Protection Branch of the Georgia Environmental Protection Division (EPD). EPD has reviewed this document and finds it acceptable. From our review, it appears that the groundwater contamination identified at HAAF-18 originated from an off-site source and is migrating onto Hunter Army Airfield property.
